ESL to Degree Admission

While enrolled in the Intensive English Program, EMU staff will assist students in applying to and beginning study in degree programs.



For admission to degree programs, students must have one of the following English scores:

Undergraduate (UG) students:

- TOEFL score of 500 (PBT) 61 (iBT)
- MELAB score of 72
- IELTS score of 6.0
- PTE score of 44

Graduate (GR) students:

- TOEFL score of 79 (iBT)
- MELAB score of 77
- IELTS score of 6.5
- PTE score of 53
