The applicant must also:

- be a resident of Monroe County.
- have completed 24 or more credit hours at an accredited Michigan college or institution with a reciprocal agreement.
- use the scholarship at an accredited Michigan college or institution with a reciprocal agreement.

Application procedure:

Applicants should submit:

1. Cover page
 - full name
 - current age
 - complete home address
 - email address and telephone number
 - high school, address, and year of graduation
 - current college, address, expected graduation date
 - title of degree being pursued
2. Copy of high school transcript and college grades to date
3. An essay that describes:
 - how you learned about and qualify for this scholarship
 - if applicable, identify MEA/MEA-R member and district(s) where employed and relationship to applicant
 - educational goals and career plans
 - work experience
 - experience with volunteer and community activities
