Complete this form to be **considered** for the federal Teacher Education Assistance for College and Higher Education (TEACH) Grant program. The TEACH Grant provides up to \$3,496 per year (\$16,000 total for 4-year undergraduate programs and \$8,000 total for graduate programs) in grants to students who commit to:

1. Teach full-time;
2. In high-need subject areas;
3. For at least four out of the first eight years teaching; and,
4. At schools that serve students from low-income families.

If the above commitments are not fulfilled, the TEACH Grant is permanently converted into a Federal Direct Unsubsidized loan to be repaid by the student recipient.

 - I have signed a TEACH Grant "Agreement to Serve and Promise to Pay" each year (available online at <https://teach-ats.ed.gov/ats/index.action>).
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I understand that the TEACH Grant program has specific service obligations that must be met in order for the award to remain as a grant. If I fail to meet all of the conditions of the award or if the conditions are not documented as required, I understand that the award will permanently convert to a Federal Direct Unsubsidized Loan and that I will be required to repay this loan with interest calculated from the disbursement date of the grant. I understand that once a TEACH Grant is converted to a loan, it cannot be converted back to grant.
