Graduate Admissions Stages and Explanations

EMU Graduate Admissions is a 3-stage process:

- Stage 1 Application Processing, where application materials are collected and prepared for review.
- Stage 2 Application Review, which includes review by the academic program and sometimes the Graduate School as well.
- Stage 3 Admission Decision Completion, where the final admission decision is registered and the applicant is notified.

It may take as little as 10 days to as long as two months for your application to go through all three stages. On average, applicants receive an admission decision within 30 days after their completing their application (through stage 1).

Factors that contribute to a longer time-to-decision include 1) the number and type of application materials required by a program, 2) the number of program faculty who review the application, 3) an application due date, and 4) the number of applications that need to be processed and reviewed.

The charts below describe what happens to applications during each stage of admissions.

Stage 1 - Application Processing

Application with Office of Admissions.	The Office of Admissions is processing your application.

	Once all of your materials are received, your application will be forwarded to the academic program you noted on your application.

Stage 2 - Application Review

Application in review.	Your application is currently being reviewed by an office on campus or is in the process of moving between offices that will review it.
Application with academic program.	Your application is being reviewed by faculty in the academic program you identified in your application.
	This review may take a few days to a couple of weeks. Also, some programs do not review applications until after an application due date.

	Please review the program's website or contact the program coordinator for more information about application review times. If you do not meet minimum Graduate School admission standards, your application will be forwarded for review by the Graduate School.
Application with Graduate School.	Your application is being reviewed by the Graduate School. This step may take up to 5 regular work days.

Stage 3 - Admissions Decision Completed

Admitted.	Congratulations! You have been admitted to EMU's Graduate School. The Office of Admissions will send you a letter with additional information in the mail.
Admitted conditionally.	Congratulations! You have been conditionally admitted to EMU's Graduate School. The Office of Admissions will send you a letter with additional information in the mail.
