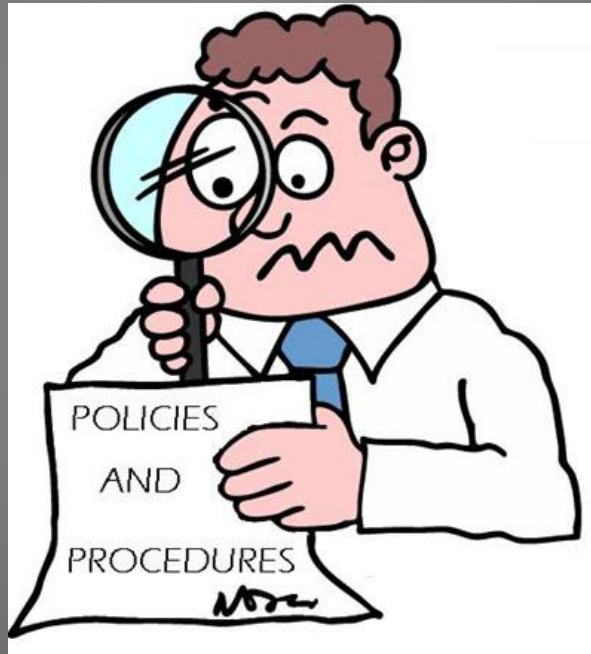
GRADUATE STUDENT RESOURCES

➤ *SEVIS requires international students to enroll in 8 credits each semester.

PROGRAM OF STUDY (POS)

- **Created with your advisor**
- Lists of all courses to complete your graduate degree (sequence, timing)
- POS needs to be submitted by the advisor to the Office of Records and Registration
- Conditional Admission
 - Must remove — communicate with your advisor

INCOMPLETE GRADES

➤ Two types of Incomplete Grades:

- “I” ~**Incomplete** grades are issued entirely at the professor’s discretion. Incompletes can only be issued when extenuating circumstances exist. To meet requirements, a student must have a B or better in the course and have completed a minimum of 50% of the course requirements.
 - Grade change: 1 year to complete the work
- “IP” ~**Incomplete in Progress** is a grade given for a thesis, dissertation, internship or capstone project.
 - Grade change may exceed one year.

COURSE WITHDRAWAL

➤ **Course Withdrawal**

- See course schedule on the Records/Registration website for deadline dates!
- If you fail to attend a course, and/or not withdraw, you will receive an F grade.
- Withdrawal from a course after the drop period may be requested. Verification of an acceptable explanation (e.g., medical report) will be required. Exceptions are not guaranteed.

ACADEMIC PROBATION

- **Probation** – overall GPA below 3.0
 - If your **semester** GPA is lower than 3.0 in any one of the two probation semesters, you will be dismissed.
 - If your **overall** GPA is below a 3.0 by the end of the second semester of probation, you will be dismissed.
- Program Dismissal can also occur due to unprofessional/unethical behavior, or not meeting program's specific policies.

GRADUATE ASSISTANTSHIPS

- Hiring and job postings through EMU Human Resources
- Time Commitment per Week: 20 hours (100% appointment)
- Tuition Waiver Credit Hours: Up to 9 per semester (100% appointment)
- Stipends vary slightly depending on the department and work you will be performing
- Stipends paid every two weeks and deposited on your Eagle Card

GRADUATE SCHOLARSHIPS

➤ Internal

- EMU Graduate School Scholarships:
 - Barton Endowed Scholarship – up to \$4,000
 - Anton Brenner Endowed Scholarship – \$500 one-time award
 - University Scholarship – between \$500 - \$4,000 per year
 - Goldenberg and Schreiber Endowed Scholarship - \$300-\$500
 - Martin Luther King Jr.-Cesar Chavez-Rosa Parks (KCP) Future Faculty Fellows

THESIS & DISSERTATION

- A culminating experience is required for ALL graduate programs (capstone, thesis, dissertation, internships, project, etc.) depending on the program requirements
- You will work with your program Advisor to determine requirements
- *IF* you are completing a thesis or dissertation, these manuals will be helpful to you. The associated forms are handled through The Graduate School.

RESEARCH COMPLIANCE

- EMU must be compliant with federal regulations in order to receive federal funding for research

PETITION SYSTEM



TIME EXTENSION (TO DEGREE)

- Max 3 years – certificate program
- Max 6 years – master's degree
- Max 6/7 years – specialist degree
- Max 7 years – doctorate degree
- Petition for time extension:

REPEATING COURSES

- A graduate course may be repeated once if the grade is a B- or lower
- The second grade is used in the GPA calculation; first grade will remain on the transcript.
- You can create a petition for an exemption to the repeating course policy here:

RESIDENCY REQUIREMENT

- Minimum number of credit hours completed at EMU once accepted and enrolled in a degree program
- Can petition for prior degree credit at:
<https://app.emich.edu/gradpetition/views/login>
 - Master's/Specialist degrees of 36 or fewer hours, at least 24 new hours must be completed at EMU
 - Master's/Specialist degrees of 37 or more hours, at least 30 new hours must be completed at EMU
 - Multiple master's/Specialist degrees must have 24 unique new hours completed at EMU
 - Certificate programs must have a minimum of 9 unique credit hours completed at EMU

MAXIMUM COURSE TYPE WAIVER

- ▶ EMU places limits on the number of certain types of courses students may count toward a graduate degree or certificate.
- ▶ Examples may be: special topics and independent study courses
