

Goff Scholarship

The Department of History and Philosophy at Eastern Michigan University is seeking applications from qualified graduate students for the Goff Scholarship. Depending upon the amount of money available, the award will pay up to 6 hours of graduate tuition for a graduate student currently working on his or her Master's thesis. Currently the Goff Scholarship stands at approximately \$1400.

To be eligible, the applicant must meet the following criteria:

- Be a graduate student in history
- Have selected the Thesis option for the MA in History program
- Be in the process of completing the last 15 hours of the degree
- Have already received approval of thesis proposal from his/her graduate advisor

Along with this application form, the applicant must also submit

- Two letters of recommendation from faculty who know the applicant's work. One of these should be from the applicant's thesis advisor
- The approved thesis proposal
- A current copy of his or her transcript

APPLICATION DEADLINE 5:00 P.M. FEBRUARY 15 (or following Monday if February 15 falls on a weekend).

Place completed application & supporting material in Professor Delph's mailbox in Department of History & Philosophy.

In deciding to make this award, the Graduate Committee will take into consideration the student's g.p.a. in history, overall g.p.a., the quality of the thesis proposal, and the two faculty recommendations. A student may only receive this award one time during his or her graduate studies in the Department of History and Philosophy at Eastern.
