Abstract: Adulthood means a lot of things: it is, first of all, a matter of trying to live a life that is personally meaningful and rewarding; at the same time, it is a matter of negotiating with the experience of aging; and it is also inescapably a matter of navigating the demands of social and interpersonal life.
