The Henry Elbert Harden Honors Scholarship honors EMU alumna Sherri Jordan's ('83) father, Henry Harden, for his entrepreneurial spirit and work within the community. Mr. Harden was a self-made businessman and community leader. Born in Mississippi in 1931, Mr. Harden moved to Flint, MI, after high school. Over the years, Mr. Harden worked on the assembly line at General Motors while also opening Harden's Grocery with his wife, Minnie Harden, in 1967. Harden's Grocery remained in business for 44 years, hosting community picnics, sponsoring local athletic teams, and providing credit to community members, as needed. This scholarship remembers and honors Henry Harden for his contributions to the community. One award of \$1000 is given annually, distributed across the fall and winter semesters.

Eligibility

Candidates for this scholarship must:

- Be a member of The Honors College and/or a member of EMU Alpha Kappa Alpha (AKA) Sorority
- Have a home address in either Michigan or New Jersey
- Have a GPA of 3.75+ at the time of application
- Demonstrate financial need, as determined by the Office of Financial Aid
- Demonstrate a record of community service
