Attend 1 Undergraduate Research Workshop

- 18 credits must be taken in General Education courses
- 3 credits must be taken in the major/minor
- 3 credits may be taken in the major, minor, or General Education courses
- A total of 24 Honors credits are required (approximately 8 classes)
- 6 credits taken in the major/minor may count for both University and Departmental Honors
- It is recommended that students take as many General Education Honors courses as possible
- Most students take two or more Honors courses per semester
- Students must maintain a 3.30 cumulative GPA to remain in The Honors College and graduate with Honors

Honors Experiences

Students must complete one Leadership/Civic Engagement Honors Experience and one Cultural/Intellectual Honors Experience.

Community Service

The Honors College is strongly committed to the value of community service. Honors students must complete a total of 40 community service hours through either community or on-campus service projects.

Star Lecture Series

Students must attend 3 Star Lectures in one academic year and submit a typed reflection paper to receive credit. This paper is an opportunity for students to revisit and analyze information. Star Lecture attendance after the original three will count towards a Cultural/Intellectual Honors Experience.
