When Your EMU Benefits End...

BASIC LIFE INSURANCE

The EMU provided life insurance benefit will end as of the date of termination if you are a staff member; or the end of the month of termination for Faculty. During the 31 days following termination of your employment, you have the option of conversion, which allows you to continue your life insurance coverage, without a medical exam. Conversion allows you to transfer the term life benefit policy to an individual life insurance policy at your own expense. Costs are available from our current provider – Aetna: 1.877.503.3448.

SUPPLEMENTAL LIFE INSURANCE

You are able to port your voluntary life insurance benefits for yourself, your spouse or your children directly through Aetna. This means you may be able to keep your supplemental life benefits without a medical exam. You must contact Aetna directly within 31 days of your termination date, at 1.877.503.3448 , to port these benefits.

FLEXIBLE SPENDING ACCOUNT (FSA)

If you are enrolled in an FSA, either for medical or dependent care, you are eligible to continue your benefit through COBRA for the remainder of the calendar year. If you would like to continue your FSA, please contact the Benefits Office at 1.734.487.3195.

MEDICAL & DENTAL

The chart below summarizes when your medical and dental benefits end. Upon termination, you may choose to continue your medical and dental benefits under a federal law, known as COBRA, which generally allows continuation, at your expense, for up to 18 months beyond termination

UNUSED VACATION TIME

If you terminate with at least one year of service, you are eligible to receive a payout of all unused vacation time based on your rate of pay at the time of termination. A Personnel Action Form (PAF) and a Separation Checklist must be processed by your department to initiate the pay out by the Payroll Office. If you terminate with less than one year of service and have used vacation time, that amount will be withheld from your final paycheck.

UNEMPLOYMENT COMPENSATION

Eastern Michigan University is covered under the Michigan Employment Security Act. If you are unemployed, you may file a claim for benefits at the Michigan Employment Security Commission (MESC) branch office nearest your home. Eligibility for benefits will be determined by MESC: 1.866.500.0017.

SOCIAL SECURITY
