The IRS issued a permanent delay to the deadline to deliver Form 1095-C to employees to March 2. Therefore, the 1095-C will come out at that time.

The form 1095-C is not needed to complete your taxes

From the IRS Website: Question #3 - Must I wait to file until I receive these forms?

- 1. If you are expecting to receive a Form 1095-A, you should wait to file your income tax return until you receive that form.
 - a. EMU issues a form 1095-C, not a 1095-A
- 2. However, it is not necessary to wait for Forms 1095-B or 1095-C in order to file.
- 3. Some taxpayers may not receive a Form 1095-B or Form 1095-C by the time they are ready to file their tax return.
- 4. While the information on these forms may assist in preparing a return, they are not required.
- 5. Individual taxpayers should not wait for these forms and file their returns as they normally would.

Like last year, taxpayers can prepare and file their returns using other information about their health insurance. You should not attach any of these forms to your tax return.

After March 2nd - The **Form 1095-C** will be available online at the BenefitFocus website. It will also be mailed. As in previous years, these documents are no longer required to complete our taxes. Your tax preparer should be advising you on these matters.

After March 2nd - HOW TO RETRIEVE YOUR FORM
