□ About the Survey:

The 2016 EMU New Graduates Employment Status Survey was launched on January 13th, 2016 and closed on March 4th, 2016. There are 4 reminders have been sent out.

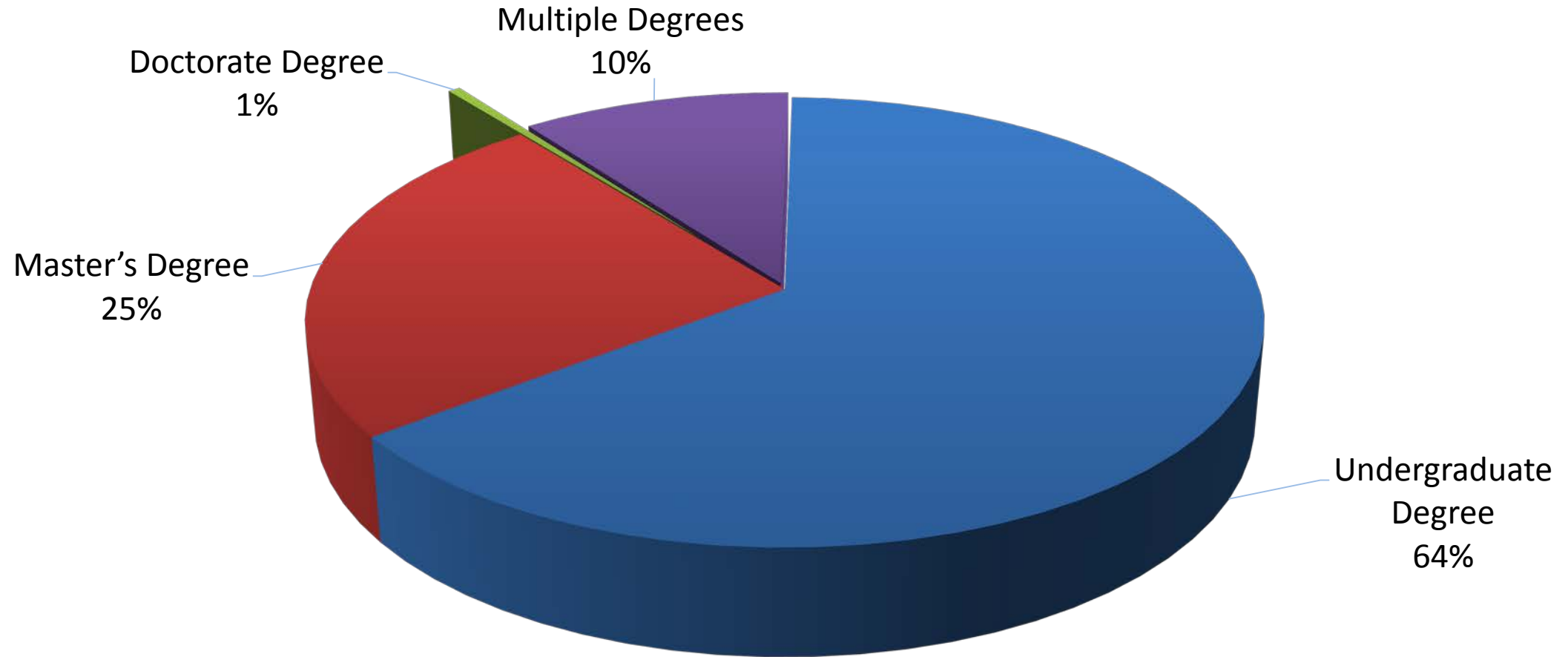
□ Methodology:

Students who graduated in the winter through the fall semester of 2015 were identified as the target group for this survey. A total of 4539 students were identified with 2968 (or 65%) undergraduate and 1571 (or 35%) graduate students. There were 865 responders or 19% response rate.

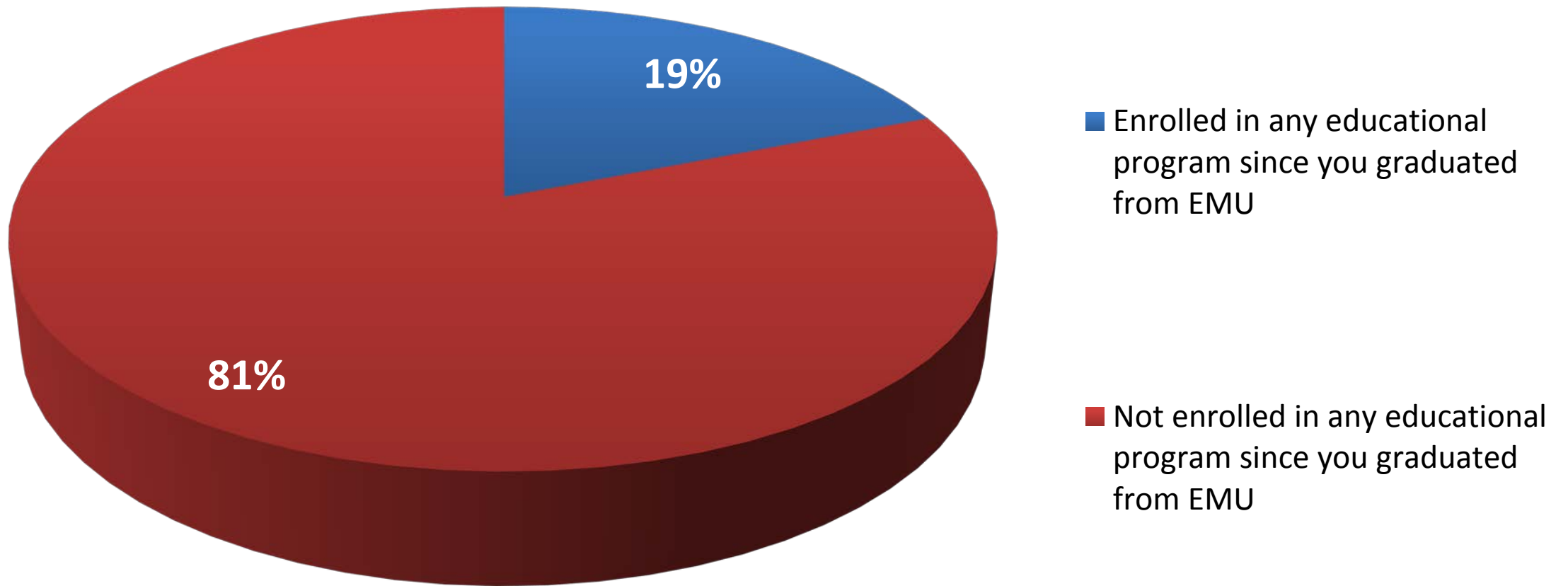

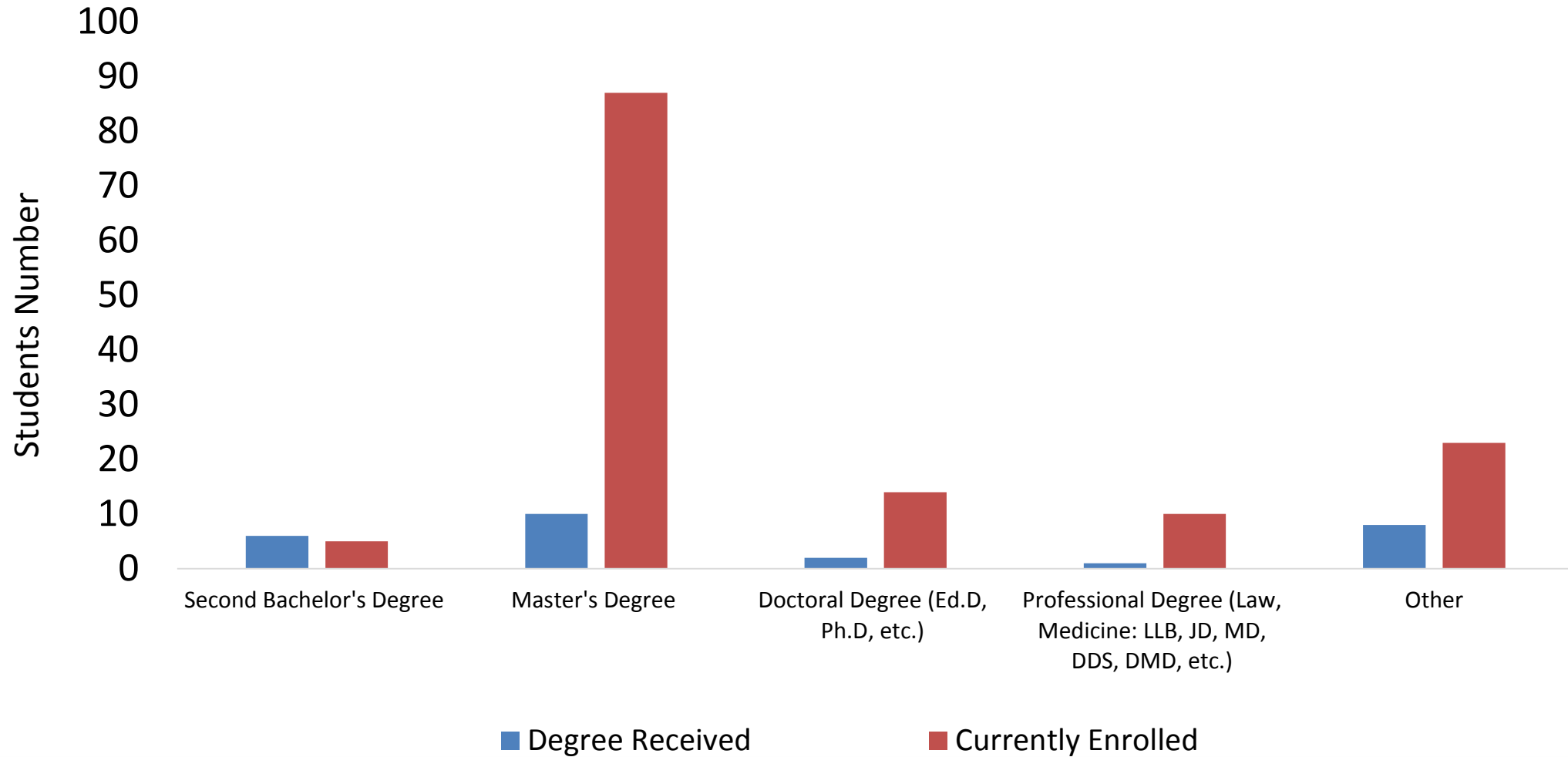
Educational Pursuit



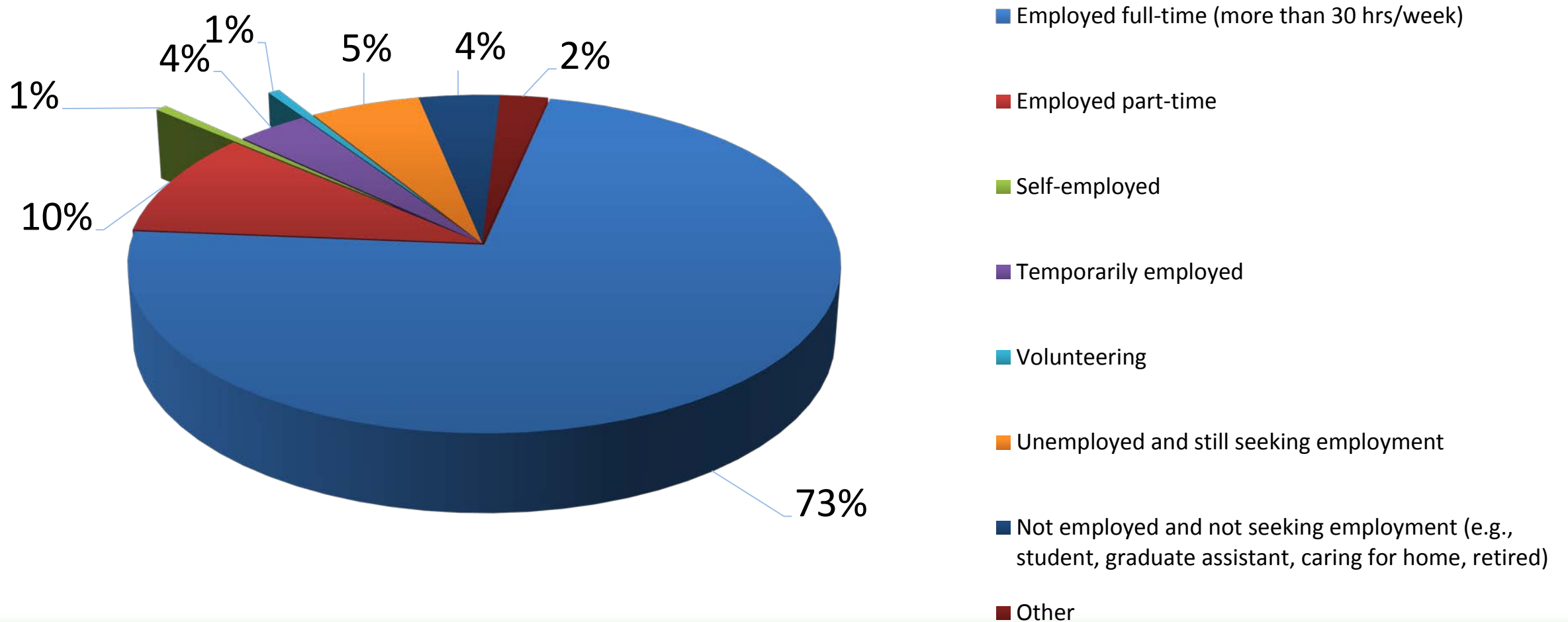
Enrollment after Graduation



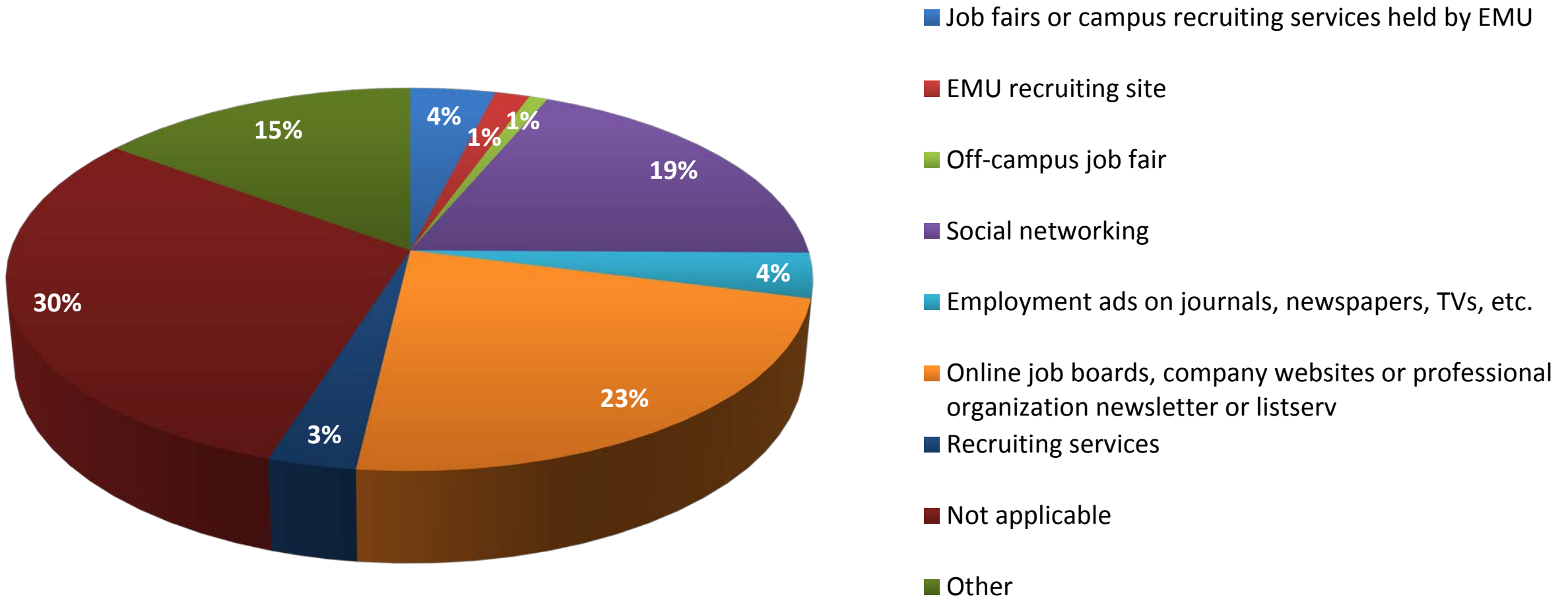
Educational Pursuit after Graduation



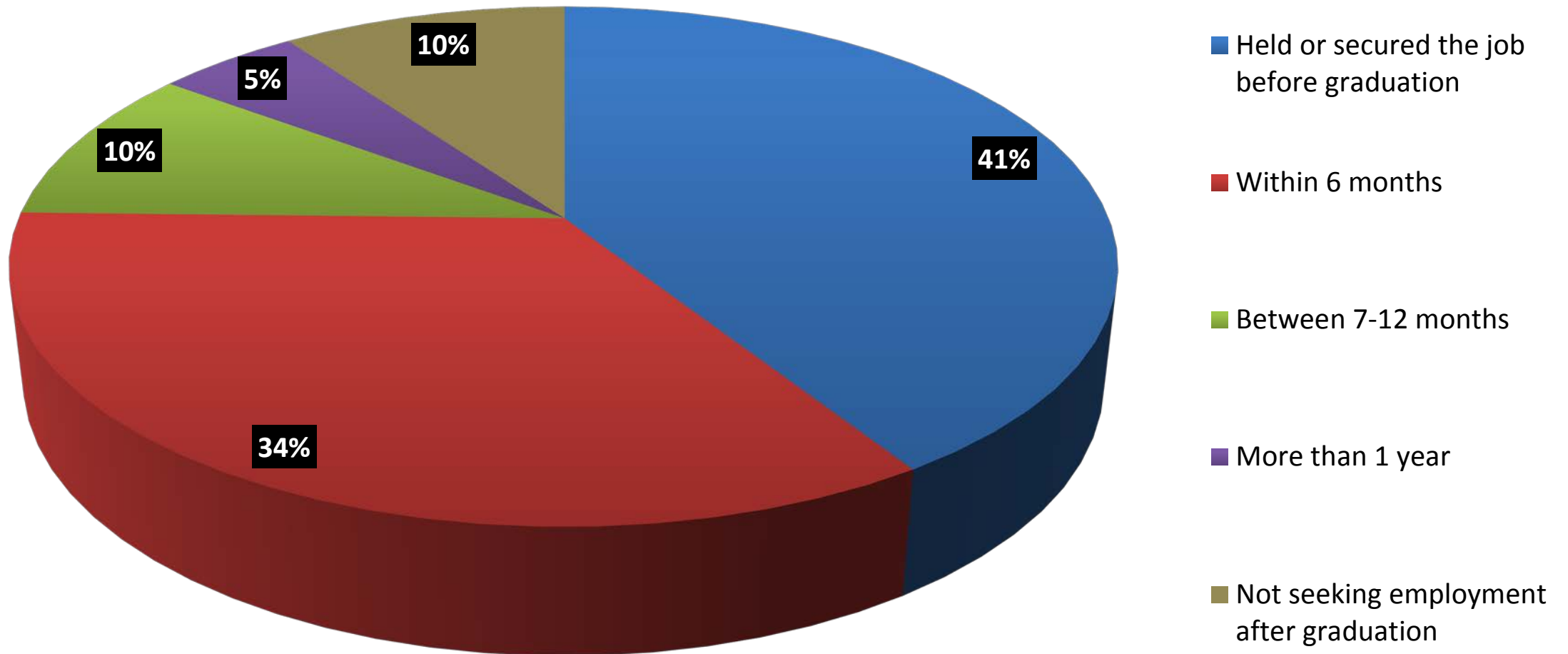
Employment Status after Graduation



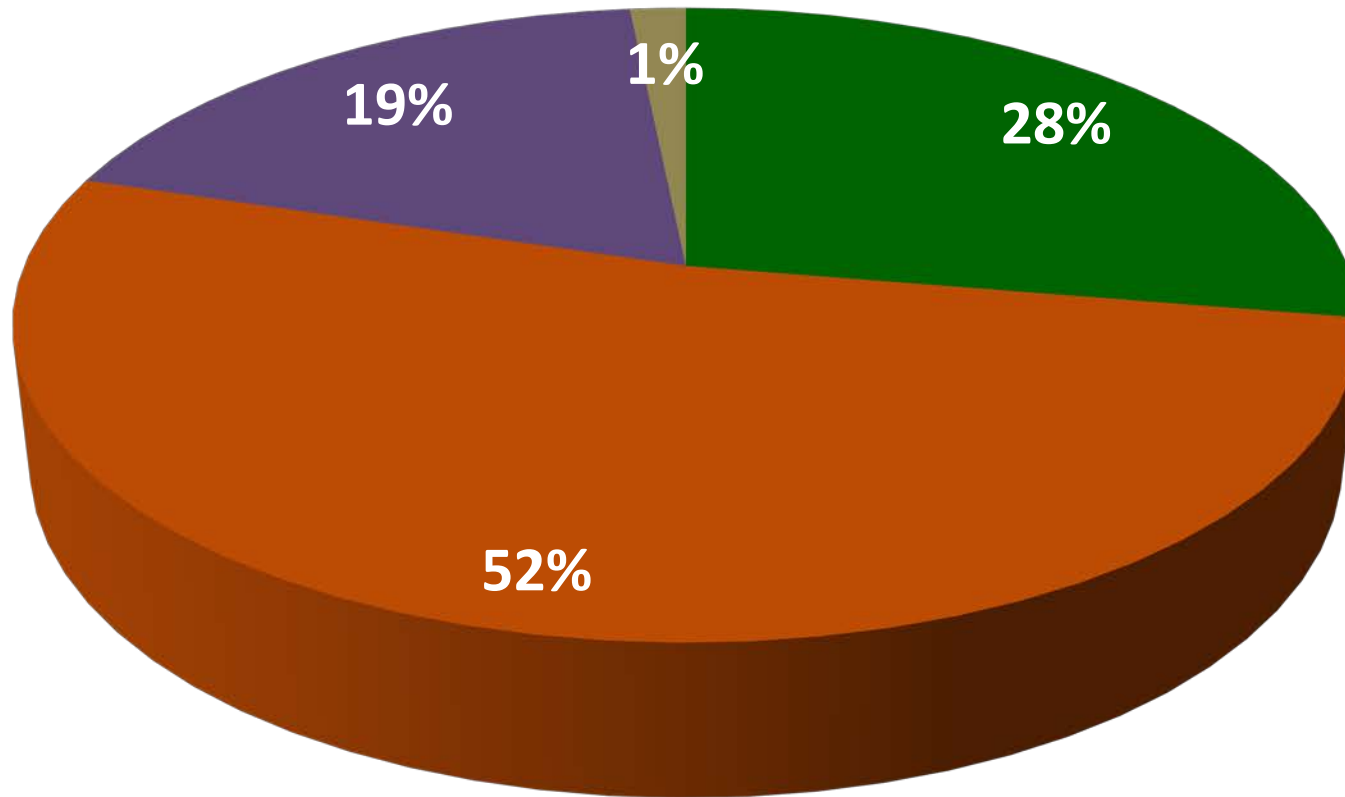
Methods for Finding Jobs after Graduation



Time to Find First Job After Graduation

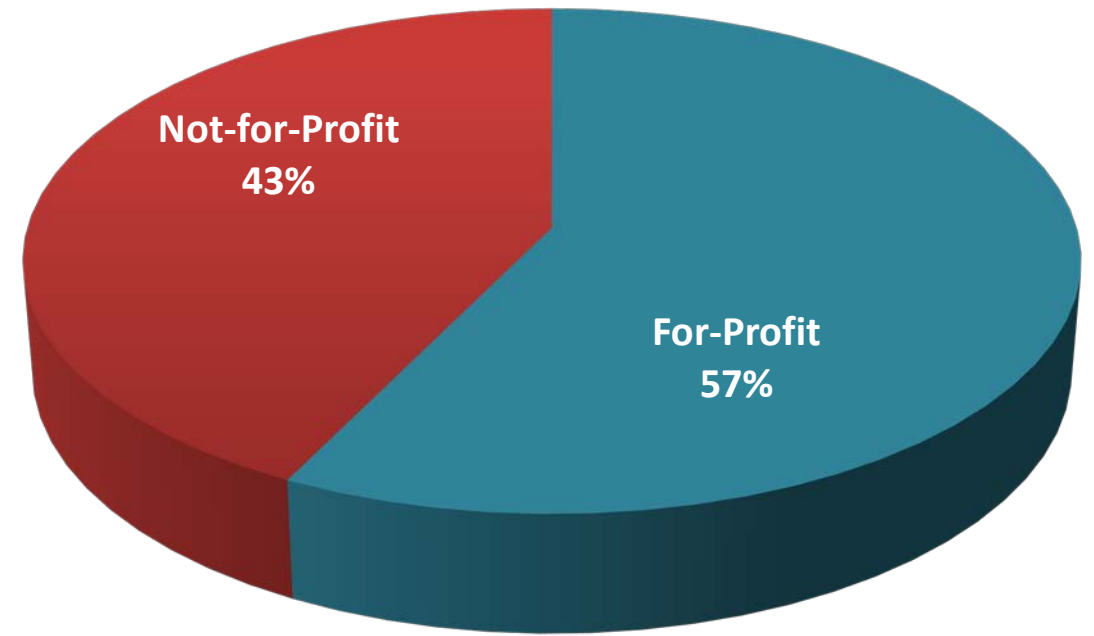
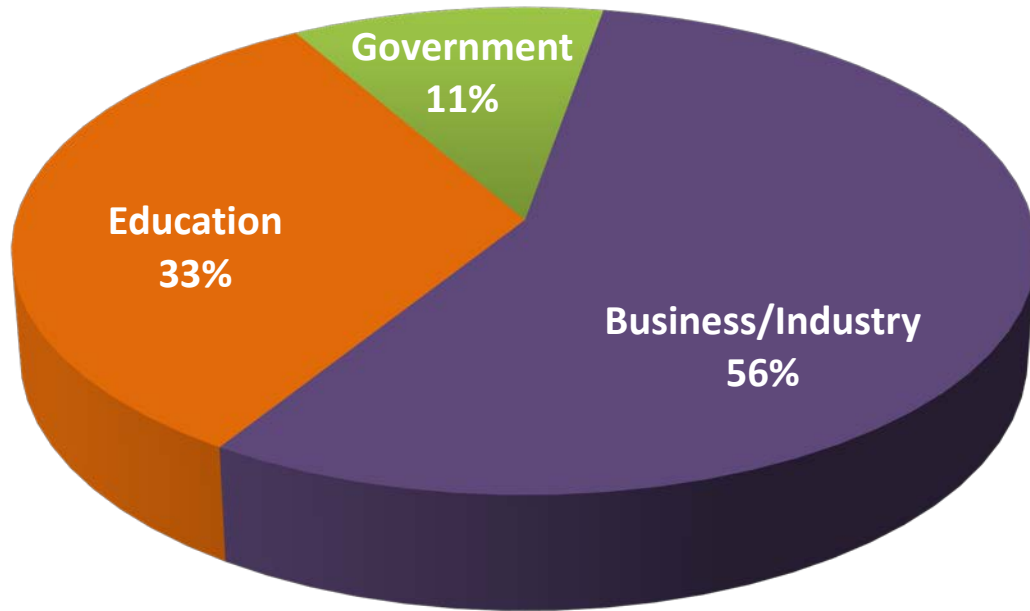


Where to Find the First Job After Graduation

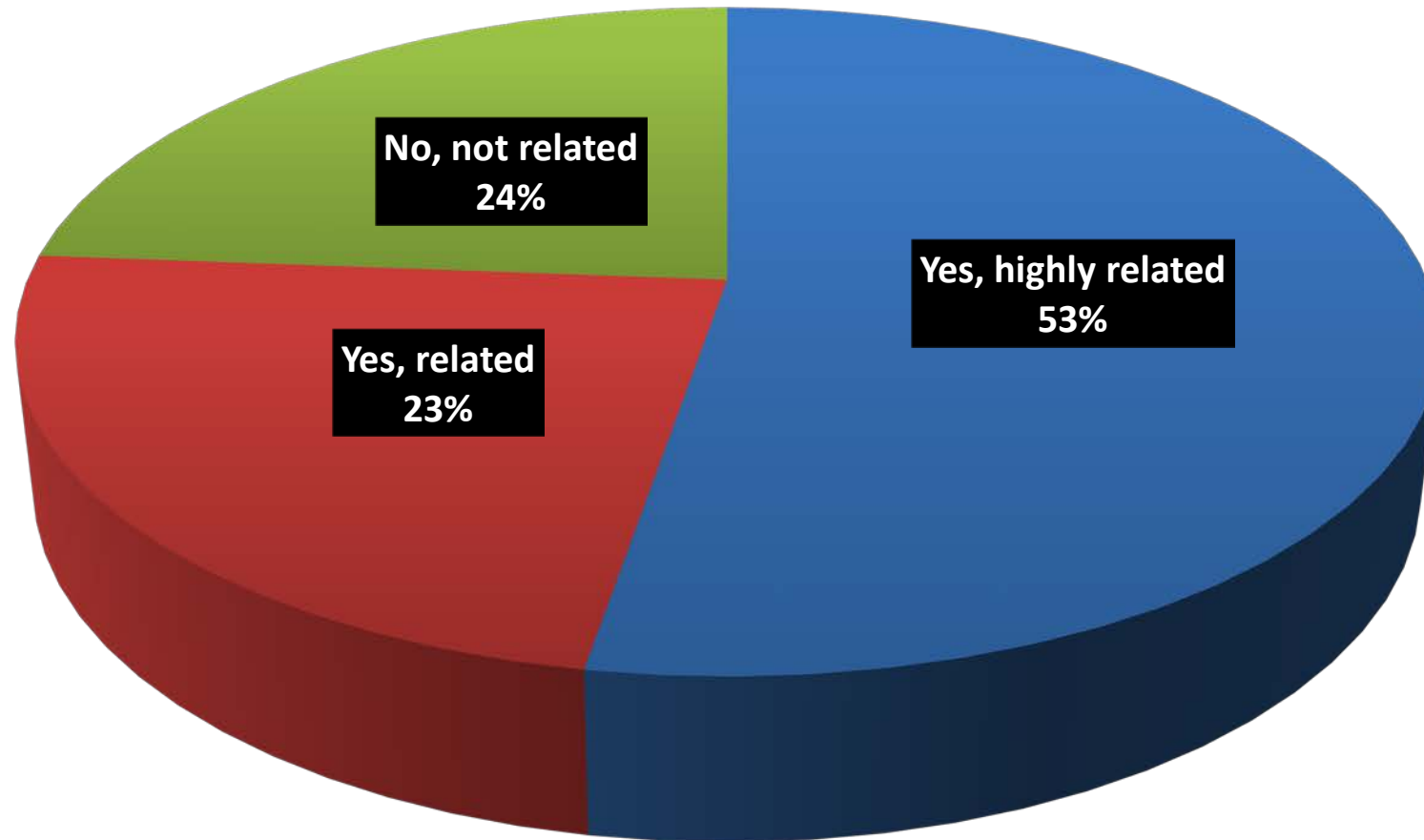

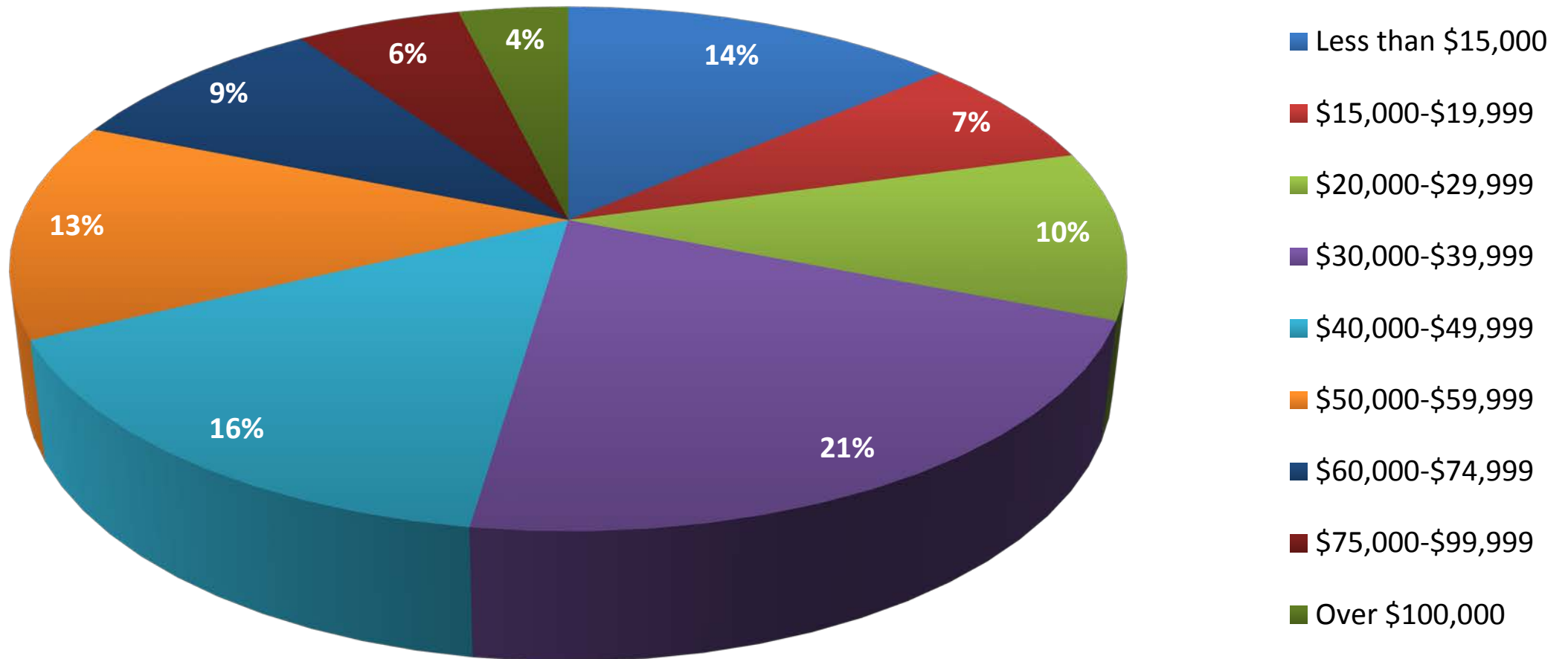

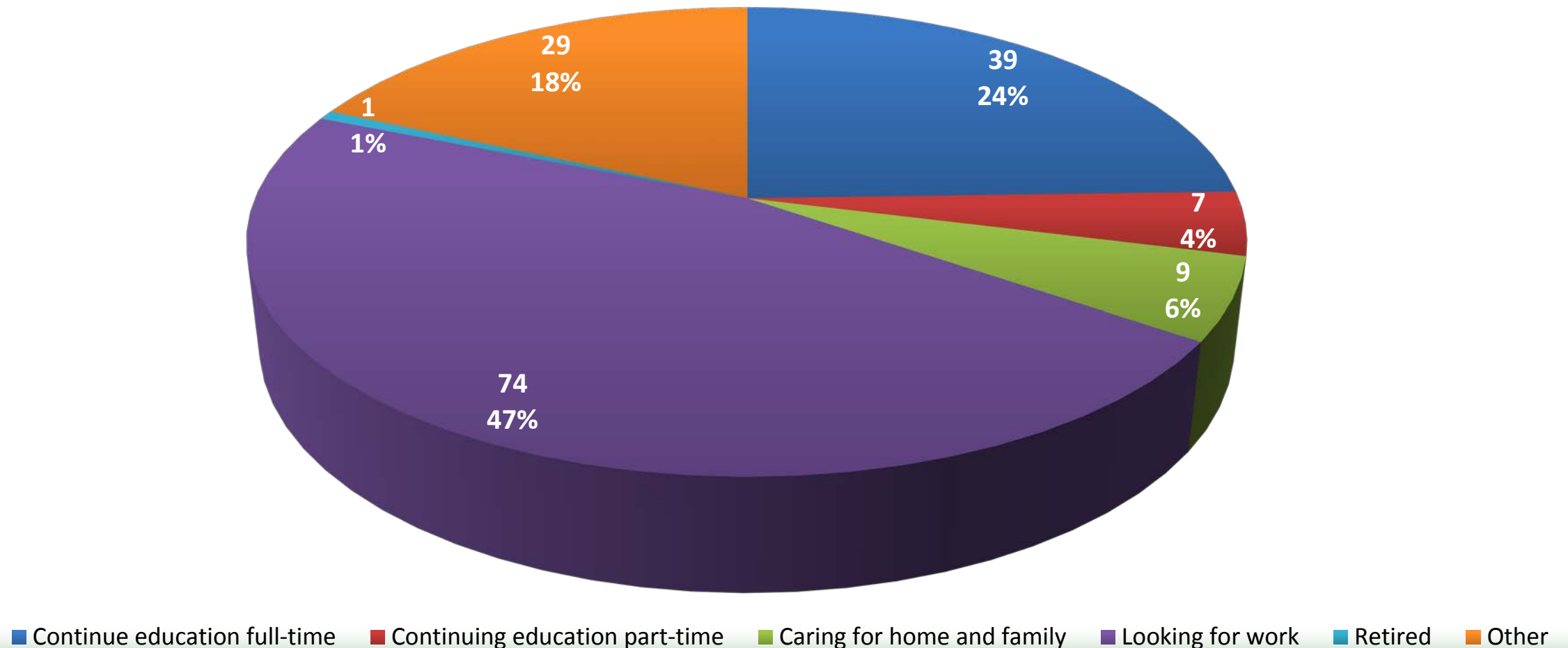
Relation between Current Position and Degree Major
