AY2018/19 Graduating Senior Survey Summary and Highlights

About the Survey

Every academic year, Eastern Michigan University (EMU) administers a voluntary survey to undergraduate students who are graduating, referred to as the graduating senior survey (GSS), to gather data regarding their experiences as a student at EMU. The survey was initially implemented in 2011, and since then we have gathered a great amount of data and provided useful feedback from our graduating seniors. During the earlier years of the survey cycle, it enjoyed as high as 48% response rate. In recent years, we have seen a steady decline in the response rate, most likely due to the ubiquitous use of online surveys in many areas and as a result of severe survey fatigue among prospective respondents. Nevertheless, with the relatively higher response rates among all survey cycles (26%-38%) over other university surveys (e.g., Housing Survey @12%, Alumni Survey @6%-12%), information gathered through the GSS also presents a more reliable picture about EMU's education and services from our students' perspectives.

During the past academic year, the GSS was administered online during in the Fall 2018, Winter 2019, and Summer 2019 semesters, which also included acquiring information regarding the graduating undergraduate student's aspirations and future plans. The GSS consists of seven general sections: Engagement of Campus Activities, Educational Experience and Academic Services, Facilities and Services at EMU, Sense of Well-Being, Plans after Graduation, College Education Funding, and an analysis of open comments, which consists of things students liked and things they thought could be improved.

The distribution of the respondents and response rates by college are summarized below.

Highlights of Results

- Engagement of Campus Activities: Students recorded the most engagement in activities sponsored by the department or school (62%), volunteer work and community service (54%), or in those activities sponsored by student organizations or student government (54%). Intercollegiate athletics had 18% of the participants at least occasionally engaged. Less than 20%

of students participated in Greek life (15%) or intercollegiate athletics (18%). Approximately 15% out of the 54% of students who participated in volunteer work or community service were partaking monthly.

- Satisfaction with Aspects of EMU: Students reported they were most satisfied with the variety of general education courses (91%), the results of the graduation audit (88%), and overall satisfaction with their major (86%). Eighty-five percent (85%) of students were overall satisfied with the intellectual challenge of courses in their major, and eighty-four percent (84%) were satisfied with the quality of general education courses.

Students had the lowest satisfaction with information provided about internships, practicum, or co-op experiences (66% of students were satisfied). Although the following ratings were the lowest among the other categories, there were 4%-5% increases in satisfaction from the 2017/18 academic school year: quality of career counseling from faculty (72%) and opportunities to discuss career choices with faculty members (75%). There was a 4% decrease in satisfaction with the academic advising from college advising offices (71%), and the level of satisfaction with academic advising from university advising center (UACDC) stayed the same as last year (74%).

- Satisfaction with Facilities and Services at EMU:** A large percentage of participants were satisfied with the Halle Library (95%) and the EMU Student Center (95%). Both the computer labs (86%) and the computer facilities provided at department/college (76%) showed significant increases in satisfaction from the 2017/2018 academic year, with both satisfaction rates increasing by 5%. While most students were satisfied with the facilities on campus, there was a 10% decrease in satisfaction with the residence halls (57% satisfaction rate). Students were highly unsatisfied with parking facilities, with a 3% decrease from the last academic school year (20%).

The Holman Learning Center (90%), The Writing Center (89%), and the SEEUS escort service (89%) all showed high satisfaction rates for the students that utilized their services. Students were the least satisfied with food services (64%) and Financial Aid counseling and services (73%).

- Sense of Well-Being:** Overall, 71% of students were satisfied with the quality of the education they received at EMU. Compared to academic year 2017/2018, all but three of the satisfaction items have increased (more satisfaction). The item with the highest satisfaction increase (5%) was experiencing a sense of belonging at EMU (61%), while the item with the most satisfaction decline (3%) was having positive interactions with staff in support services (77%). In addition, students' attitudes about their university can be anticipated through their potential referral to others, and 64% indicated they would refer EMU to others (the same as from the previous academic year).

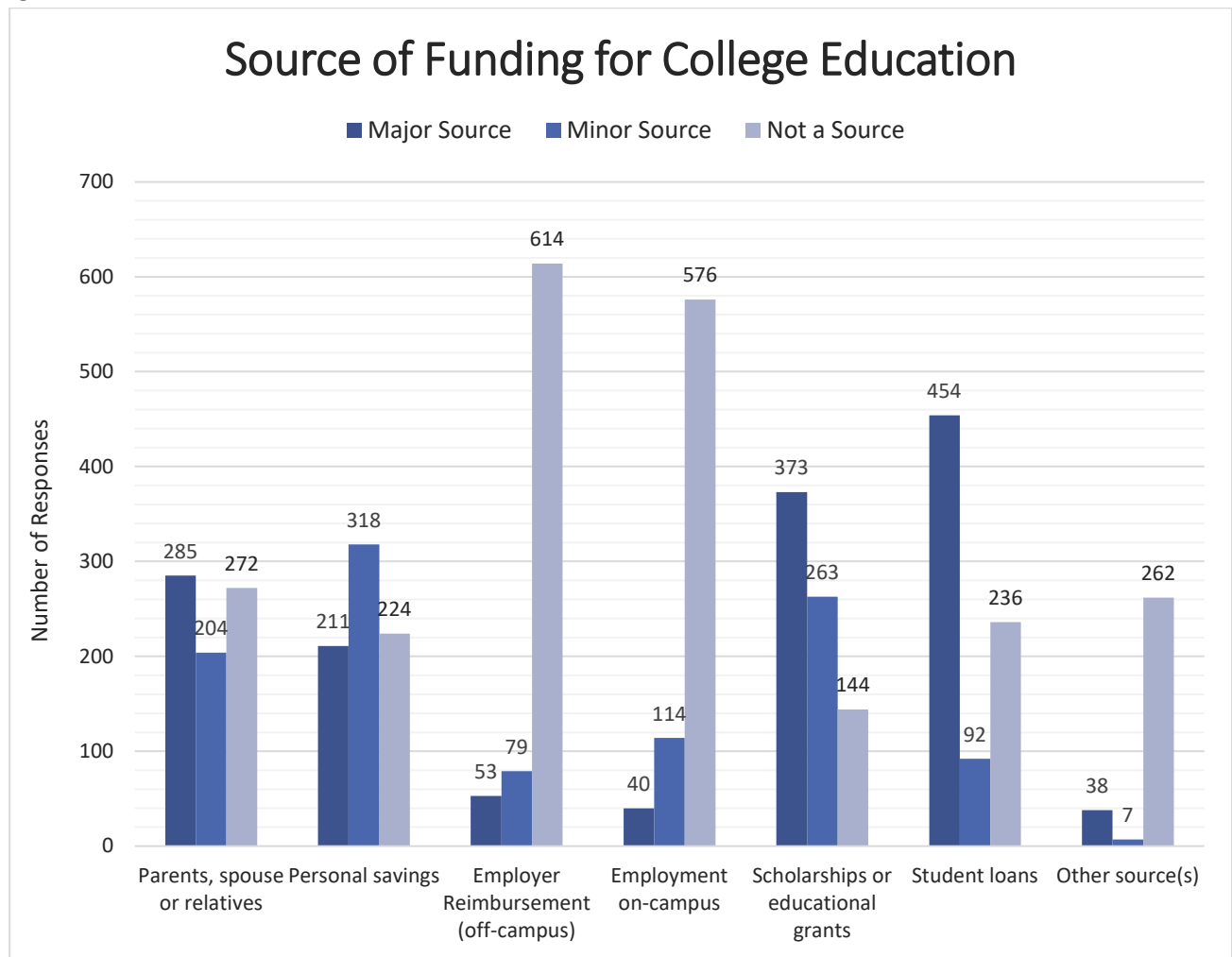

- Plans after Graduation: A total of 600 students responded to the question regarding their employment status, and of those students 33% (199) said they would continue in their current full-time employment and 31% (186) said they would begin full-time employment upon graduation. Approximately 27% (161) of students indicated they are still seeking employment. Of the 265 students who provided information regarding their current or future place of employment, 93% (246) of the responding students reported they are employed within the state of Michigan.

When the students were asked to estimate what they would be doing after graduation, of the 802 student responses, 57% (461) indicated they planned on working or volunteering full-time, 17% (136) planned to work and continue their education part-time, 17% (133) indicated they were going to pursue further education as a full-time student, and less than 1% (4) reported they were undecided. A total of 613 students reported they planned to further formal study in the future. Within these results, 80% (489) indicated they planned to get a master's degree at some point in the future, 16% (101) reported they planned to get a doctorate degree at some point in the future, and 8% (50) planned on earning a professional degree. Eighteen percent (110) of students reported they planned to pursue some type of certificate or professional licensure and 7% (44) planned to pursue a second bachelor's degree.

- College Education Funding: A total of 782 students responded to the question regarding the source of funding for their college education. Student loans were the most prevalent major source of funding at 58% of students, and the second largest source was scholarships or educational grants at 48%. Common minor sources of funding were personal savings (41%) and scholarship or educational grants (34%). Many students reported they did not use employer reimbursement off-campus (79%) or on-campus (74%) as a source of funding for their education. The remaining results are reported in Figure 1.

Thematic Analysis of Open Comments

At the end of the survey, two open-ended questions with regards to student comments about EMU were asked.

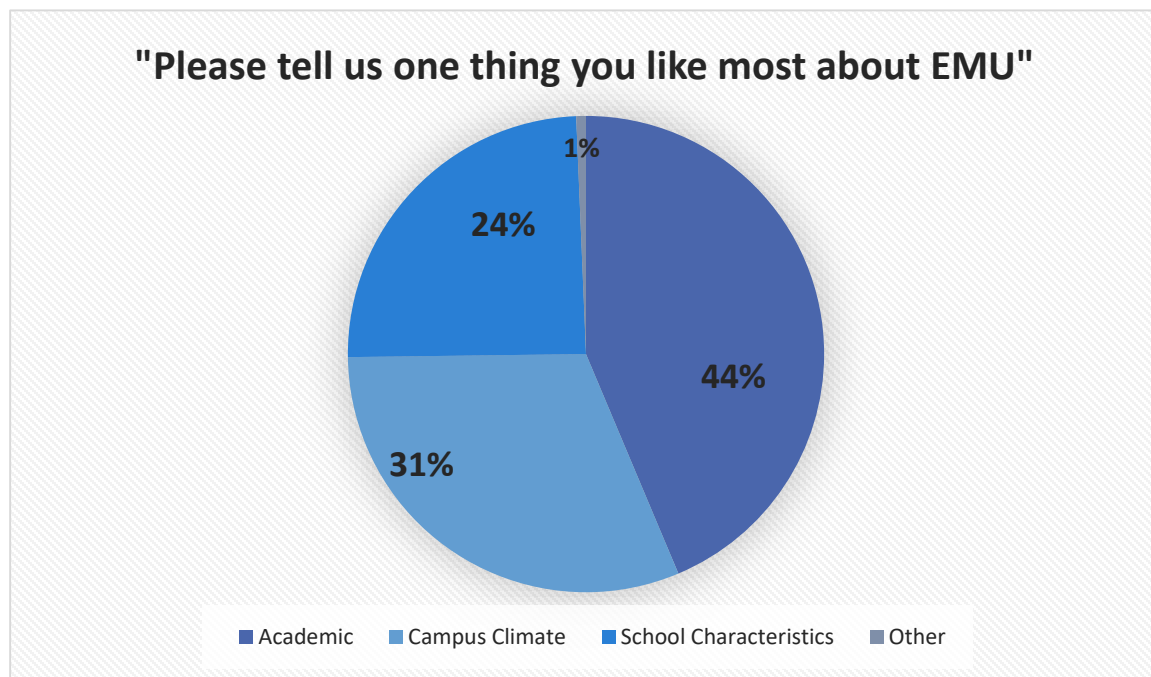
Q1: *Please tell us one thing you like most about EMU.*

For each question, the percentage correlating with the student's response rate is presented below in Figure 2 and Figure 3, each followed by excerpts of student responses within each category.

Q1: Please tell us one thing that you like most about EMU.

There were 606 student responses.

Academics:

Faculty, courses (157 responses, 26%)

- "The faculty was amazing, and was the best part about my entire time at EMU."
- "I enjoyed the amazing faculty and how they truly wanted me to succeed and went out of their way to help."
- "I enjoyed the dedication and genuine care that the faculty has in helping students succeed and work towards their goals after college. It has been very helpful in the four years that I have attended school here."

Program, college, quality of education (80 responses, 13%)

- “The high quality of academic programs.”
- “The PR program really prepared me for the real world work environment and provided me with a viable skill set!”
- “I enjoyed the program that I was in and the education that I received.”

Flexibility of class schedule or location (28 responses, 5%)

- “The classes were easily manageable while working full time. I loved that I could do the whole RN to BSN completion program online.”
- “I like that they are commuter and full-time work friendly with plenty of evening class offerings.”

Campus Climate:

Services provided, internship opportunities, administrative staff (25 responses, 4%)

- “The availability of tutoring and career fairs.”
- “It is very easy to figure out what classes you need to take and register for classes.”
- “Military and veteran resource center was like a home away from home.”

Friendly atmosphere, community-like, sense of belonging (59 responses, 10%)

- “The community feel, I always felt welcomed starting from my first day of classes.”
- “The charm of the campus and the people on it.”
- “At EMU I felt a sense of belonging and that there was a community of people that shared similar beliefs and values that I could be a part of.”

Small class size, close interactions with faculty and students (37 responses, 6%)

- “I loved the small classes, that leaves room for more personable relationships for academic improvement.”
- “I liked the small class sizes, making it easier to interact with the teachers and concentrate better.”
- “I liked building relationships with peers and faculty in my major.”

Campus life, student organizations, student work experience (32 responses, 5%)

- “EMU really supports and encourages student organizations.”
- “Opportunity for growth through student organizations and opportunities through EMU.”
- “I liked the variety of event and clubs one could join. I was in several on-campus clubs and I liked being part of every one of them.”

Diversity of population, student interaction (36 responses, 6%)

- “I enjoy the variety of cultural influences and the genuine people I have met throughout my time here. I have felt very comfortable living on campus the entirety of my time at Eastern, and feel very at home here.”
- “I enjoy the diverse group of students and the fact that the university supports that diversity.”

School Characteristics:

Beautiful campus, facilities, proximity of buildings (86 responses, 14%)

- “I like that the buildings are laid out in a way that keeps walking time short and easy to be on time.”
- “The scenery is what drew me in.”

Location (18 responses, 3%)

- “I like the convenience of the school, it’s relatively close to home and easy to come here.”
- “I lived 6 minutes down the road so the commute was very easy.”

Affordability (25 responses, 4%)

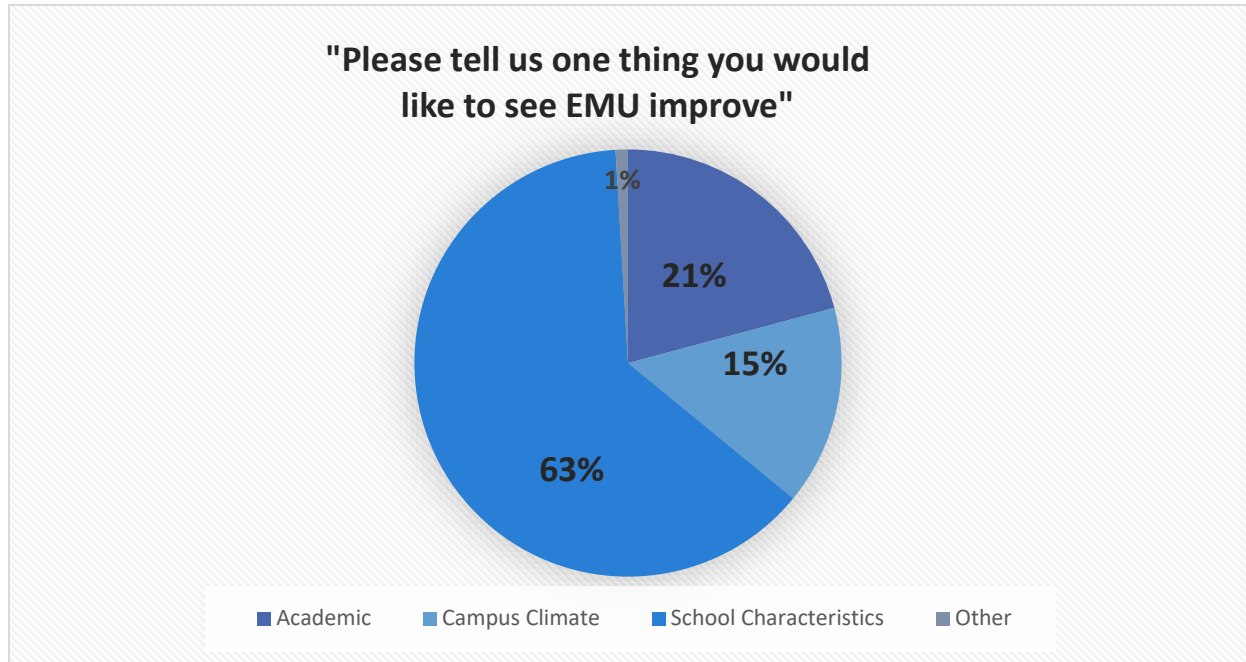
- “More affordable than most other universities.”
- “The price, it is the best in the state of Michigan in that regard.”

Students (20 responses, 3%)

- “The many friends I have made over the past four years.”
- “The chance to work with other like-minded students allowed me to develop my skills and learn new techniques.”
- “The people I met and formed relationships with.”

Q2: Please tell us one thing you would like to see EMU improve.

There were 644 student responses.

Academics:

Faculty, teaching skills, courses (55 responses, 9%)

- "I would like to see the general education credits required be improved. More career relevant courses should be offered."
- "Getting rid of Professors who constantly get reported or complaints filed towards them."
- "Teacher and curriculum quality. Instructors varied so much in how well or poorly they taught classes. I had a few really good experiences where I felt like I learned a lot, and many experiences where I felt that my classes were a waste of time and I didn't learn anything."

Program, college, quality of education (64 responses, 10%)

- "IA program is not rigorous. It's too easy. A lot of students get through the program by barely showing up to class."
- "Expand available programs."
- "Increase workload. It felt like the BBA degree was too easy. Myself and another student both discussed this. Almost as if you pay the money, sit in the class and get a degree."

Flexibility of class schedule or location (15 responses, 2%)

- "Flexibility of classes for cleaner was very difficult. Juggling work and family outside of school was very difficult. My department offered very little leeway in terms of override and scheduling issues."
- "More variety of class times for those that are working, i.e. online classes and evening classes."

Campus Climate:

Services provided, administration staff, financial aid service (46 responses, 7%)

- “Communication between offices, such as records and registration with student business services.”
- “I would like to see a better performance from administration staff.”
- “Response to students from office employees.”

Friendly atmosphere, community-like, sense of belonging (12 responses, 2%)

- “Better sense of community, especially with commuters.”
- “The sense of community that they advertise.”

Campus life, student organization (19 responses, 3%)

- “I would like to see EMU improve its campus life. Campus is not very lively and that is really sad for someone looking for the college experience.”
- “More campus events to promote student involvement.”

Diversity of population, student interaction (14 responses, 2%)

- “Faculty should be more considerate of diversity and differences.”
- “I would like to see more diversity in the faculty.”

Safety/law (7 responses, 1%)

- “Safety. I avoided taking night classes to the best of my ability for FIVE years because I did not feel comfortable or safe on/off campus.”
- “Safety around campus.”

School Characteristics:

Parking (208 responses, 32%)

- “Parking. I believe every student will put this down as an issue. It has always been a major issue. But I definitely feel that contracting out the parking came as an almost betrayal to the student population rather than the university tackling parking issues head on.”
- “Parking. This has been a problem since 2008. Please make more parking. This has been a major problem.”
- “Parking. Prices are raised every semester yet... not enough parking.”
- “I think they need to embrace that it is a commuter school and make it more commuter friendly with parking.”
- “Parking vendor.”

Campus, facilities, proximity (75 responses, 12%)

- “Residence halls and some campus facilities need to be renovated.”
- “A lot of building are old and falling apart. It’s embarrassing.”
- “Better maintenance on crumbling buildings and sidewalks.”

Affordability, EMU budgeting (104 responses, 16%)

- “It feels like university administrators are continuing to invest less in students and moving closer to privatization. My department had to lay off several people because the university continues to spend an exorbitant amount on the football program. These cuts are continuing to impact opportunities for students.”
- “EMU is supposed to be a public university, and yet it seems that it is private in everything but name anymore. This excessive privatization has caused a severe decline in the quality of the services provided.”
- “Stop trying to bleed your students dry. Stop privatizing everything on campus at the direct expense of students.”
- “Do not continue to privatize services, especially housing. It is to the detriment of students and is the main reason why I don't recommend anyone else go to Eastern when asked.”

Food (18 responses, 3%)

- “There really needs to be more options for people with dietary restrictions. I struggled to eat on campus which was the primary reason I moved off campus.”
- “More sustainable food options for vegetarian and vegan residents.”
- “Food needs to improve a great deal. It has gotten a little better but it's not many different food options throughout campus.”

Other:

Other (6 responses, 1%)

- “Every single aspect that a formal institution is supposed to honor and represent.”
- “Everything.”
