## AY2021/22 Graduating Senior Survey Summary and Highlights

#### About the Survey

Every academic year, Eastern Michigan University (EMU) administers a voluntary survey to undergraduate students who are graduating, referred to as the graduating senior survey (GSS), to gather data regarding their experiences as a student at EMU. The survey was initially implemented in 2011, and since then we have gathered a great amount of data and provided useful feedback from our graduating seniors. For the academic year 2021-2022, the response rate of GSS was 37 %. More than 1,000 respondents participated the survey and submitted valuable information. The information gathered through the GSS also presents a more reliable picture about EMU's education and services from our students' perspectives.

During the past academic year, the GSS was administered online during in the fall 2021, winter 2022, and summer 2022 semesters, which also included acquiring information regarding the graduating undergraduate student's aspirations and future plans. The GSS consists of seven general sections: Engagement of Campus Activities, Educational Experience and Academic Services, Facilities and Services at EMU, Sense of Well-Being, Plans after Graduation, College Education Funding, and an analysis of open comments, which consists of things students liked and things they thought could be improved.

The distribution of the respondents and response rates by college are summarized below.

#### Highlights of Results

Engagement of Campus Activities: Students recorded the most engagement in activities sponsored by the department or school (50%), activities sponsored by student organizations or student government (45%), or in volunteer work and community service those (44%). Oncampus artistic performances or exhibitions have a fairly high participation rate (36%). Approximately 22% students have participated in campus recreation activities. Less than 20% of students participated in Greek life (13%) or intercollegiate athletics (16%).

#### Satisfaction with Aspects of EMU:

This part of survey includes 16 questions regarding how satisfied graduating senior students are with 16 aspects of EMU. The formula of computing satisfaction rate is as follows:

Number of (Very Satisfied + Satisfied responses) / (Total responses – N.A. responses) \* 100%

The average satisfaction rate with these 16 aspects of EMU is 82%, which is an increase of one percent from the 2019/20 academic school year.

Students reported they were most satisfied with the variety of general education courses (92%) and graduation audit (92%). Both rise this year, increasing by 1%. Nighty percent (90%) students are satisfied with the intellectual challenge of courses in their major, and the percentage numbers for overall satisfaction with their major and quality of general education courses are 89% and 86%.

Students had the lowest satisfaction with information provided about internships, practicum, or co-op experiences (70% of students were satisfied). Although the following ratings were the lowest among the other categories, four of them still increase in satisfaction from the 2020/21

academic school year: levels of satisfaction with Information provided about internships, practicum or co-op experiences (70%), Quality of career counseling from faculty (72%), Opportunities to discuss career choices with faculty members (74%), and levels of satisfaction with academic advising from university advising center (UACDC) (77%).

Satisfaction with Facilities and Services at EMU: The average satisfaction rate with facilities at EMU is 81%, the same as the 2020/2021 academic year. A large percentage of participants were satisfied with the Halle Library (95%) and the EMU Student Center (95%). The remaining facilities (7 out of 9) showed stability in satisfaction from the 2020/2021 academic year. Notably, there was an 6% increase in satisfaction with Computer facilities provided at your department/college from the last academic year (86% satisfaction rate). While most students were satisfied with the facilities on campus, students were highly dissatisfied with parking facilities, with the lowest satisfaction rate (34%) among all facilities.

The average satisfaction rate with services at EMU is 84%, which is a one percent increase from the 2020/2021 academic year. The SEEUS escort service (93%), The Writing Center (91%), International Student Service (90%) and Services from Disability Resource Center (90%) all

showed high satisfaction rates for the students that utilized their services. Students were the least satisfied with food services (68%).

• Sense of Well-Being: Compared to academic year 2020/2021, all but three of the satisfaction items have decreased (less satisfied). Overall, 74% of students were satisfied with the quality of the education they received at EMU, decreasing 2% from the last academic year. In addition, students' attitudes about their university can be anticipated through their potential referral to others; 65% indicated they would refer EMU to others, which 4% lower than last year. The three items with the satisfaction rise (1-2%) were positive interactions with staff, fellow students and faculty.

Plans after Graduation: A total of 639 students responded to the question regarding their employment status, and of those students 34% (217) said they would continue in their current full-time employment and 33% (213) said they would begin full-time employment upon graduation. Approximately 23% (147) of students indicated they are still seeking employment. Of the 278 students who provided information regarding their current or future place of employment, 88% (245) of the responding students reported they are employed within the state of Michigan.

When the students were asked to estimate what they would be doing after graduation, of the 867 student responses, 59% (509) indicated they planned on working or volunteering full-time, 13% (109) planned to work and continue their education part-time, 12% (106) indicated they were going to pursue further education as a full-time student, and less than 8% (68) reported they were undecided.

A total of 852 students reported they planned to further formal study in the future. Within these results, 53% (448) indicated they planned to get a master's degree at some point in the future, 11% (92) reported they planned to get a doctorate degree at some point in the future, and 4% (33) planned on earning a professional degree. Thirteen percent (113) of students reported they planned to pursue some type of certificate or professional licensure and 5% (45) planned to pursue a second bachelor's degree.

• College Education Funding: A total of 832 students responded to the question regarding the source of funding for their college education. Student loans were the most prevalent major source of funding at 56% of students, and the second largest source was scholarships or educational grants at 44%. Common minor sources of funding were personal savings (37%) and scholarship or educational grants (33%). Many students reported they did not use employer reimbursement off-campus (78%) or employment on-campus (83%) as a source of funding for their education. The remaining results are reported in Figure 1.

#### **Thematic Analysis of Open Comments**

At the end of the survey, two open-ended questions with regards to student comments about EMU were asked.

Q1: Please tell us one thing you like most about EMU.

Q2: Please tell us one thing you would like to see EMU improve.

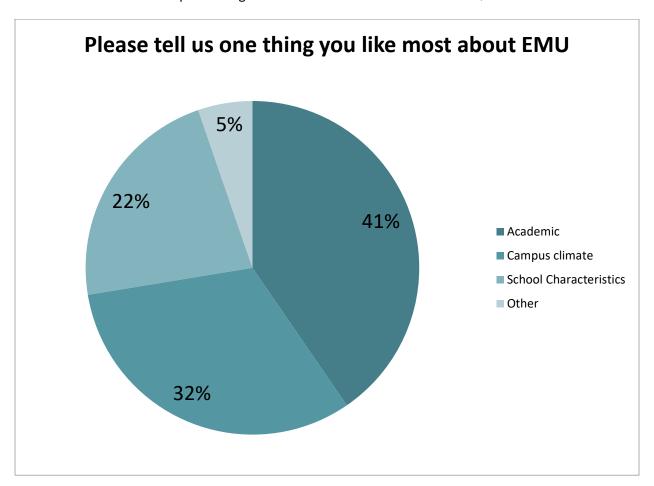


Figure 2 Please tell us one thing you like most about EMU

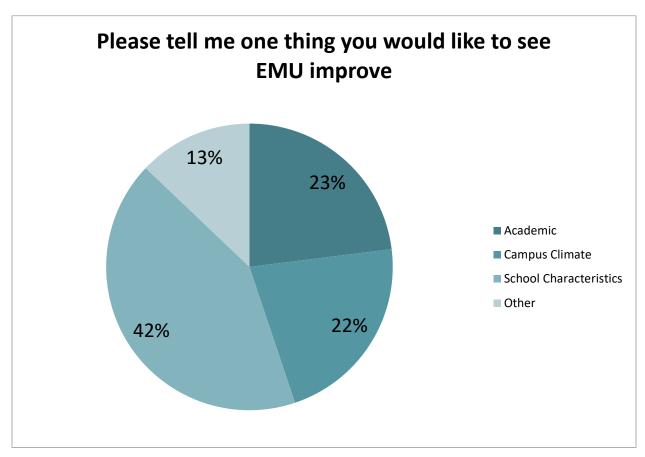


Figure 3. Please tell us one thing you would like to see EMU improve

For each question, the percentage correlating with the student's response rate is presented below in Figure 2 and Figure 3, each followed by excerpts of student responses within each category.

Q1: Please tell us one thing that you like most about EMU.

There were 569 student responses. Figure 2 is the distribution of answers to Q1.

#### **Academics**:

Faculty, courses (161 responses, 28%)

- "Working with passionate and knowledgeable faculty who took an interest in the wellbeing and success of students."
- "The wonderful teachers"
- "The way the university responded and adapted to COVID restrictions. Some professors clearly weren't anticipating teaching online, but they rallied and maintained the high-quality education for all students whether in person or online."

Program, college, quality of education (71 responses, 12%)

- "I really liked the quality of my degree from EMU! The education program is great and at a reasonable price."
- "I really enjoyed most of my classes. I felt like I received a well-rounded education. Some of the staff was especially inspiring and motivating. I'm very happy that I got my teacher education here. I especially liked those classes and the material taught."
- "I love the music department. Even though I am a biology major the faculty and the students in the music department felt like family."

Flexibility of class schedule or location (25 responses, 4%)

- "I loved the convenience of being able to earn my BSN online. Faculty were supportive and flexible with students who worked full time."
- "EMU has a number of fully or mostly online degree programs, these are very flexible for students that have a full-time career occupation."

#### **Campus Climate:**

Services provided, internship opportunities, administrative staff (109 responses, 19%)

- "Advising for major was extremely helpful, career services help me greatly for after graduation plans, faculty was helpful and mentoring, and peers became great friends."
- "The staff are phenomenal"
- "The transfer process was great. My advisors were on point about what courses to take and when to take them."

Friendly atmosphere, community-like, sense of belonging (60 responses, 11%)

- "Sense of belonging"
- "The one thing I loved about EMU was the sense of community that the school had."

Small class size, close interactions with faculty and students (27 responses, 5%)

- "I love the opportunity for smaller class sizes in freshmen classes in the honors college."
- "I have loved the opportunities I have received. By asking professors and staff at Eastern, I have
  had a significant amount of success in finding opportunities on and off-campus. The small class
  sizes have allowed me to really get to know my professors and I have always felt supported by
  the professors here at Eastern."
- "The small class sizes"

Campus life, student organizations, student work experience (19 responses, 3%)

• "The different organizations that we have to offer, a lot of colleges don't offer as many student organizations that we do. It made the college experience better being a part of something with people that come from the same background as me."

• "One thing I liked about EMU was that there was always a way to connect with anyone with all the fun events that were held."

Diversity of population, student interaction (20 responses, 4%)

- "It is very diverse."
- "I love the diversity of our university and how inclusive we work to be across campus and I love the size of the university itself because it is big enough to know some people across campus, but not have to know everyone."

#### **School Characteristics:**

Beautiful campus, facilities, proximity of buildings (18 responses, 3%)

- "Campus is beautiful"
- "Having all of my classes in the same building"

Location (10 responses, 2%)

- "Close proximity to my neighborhood"
- "EMU is in a great location for where I am from."

Affordability (5 responses, 1%)

- "It was relatively affordable."
- "It seems to be cost-efficient"

Students (3 responses, 1%)

- "The students are all great in the nursing program."
- "The students and overall EMU community."

Q2: Please tell us one thing you would like to see EMU improve.

There were 582 student responses. Figure 3 is the distribution of answers to Q2.

#### **Academics:**

Faculty, teaching skills, courses (76 responses, 13%)

- "Training professors on teaching virtually"
- "Quality of instructors. Most instructors during my time here seemed unenthusiastic about having to teach."
- "The quality of instructors."

Program, college, quality of education (39 responses, 7%)

- "More variety of courses for the Biology majors, and adding Biopsychology major."
- "Quality of education in some classes"
- "More up to date learning in marketing degree. I would like it to have been more relatable and helpful for future jobs. "

Flexibility of class schedule or location (17 responses, 3%)

- "I would like EMU to maybe have more times available for upper-level classes."
- "Offer more online asynchronous classes"

#### **Campus Climate:**

Services provided, administration staff, financial aid service (101 responses, 17%)

- "Better staff and comprehension of how teaching works."
- "Better advising support for older returning students."

Friendly atmosphere, community-like, sense of belonging (50 responses, 9%)

- "A feeling of inclusion or welcoming. Especially for transfer students."
- "One thing I would like to see EMU improve is community building geared towards commuters. Although I felt accepted on campus as a woman of color, I also commute. Although I do not mind commuting, it is harder to build community. Since EMU is a majority commuter school, there should be a lot more money/time/effort into developing and helping them thrive on campus by giving them opportunities to build community. I know this is something many commuters feel, so I would love to see it happen! I would highly suggest EMU investing in their commuter students because this would also boost graduation rates as well as prevent students from transferring to other universities."

Campus life, student organization (29 responses, 5%)

- "More student life involvement (on campus, at athletics, etc.)"
- "More areas for students to get involved on campus. There were so many opportunities for Campus Life pre-Covid and they were all advertised really well. Now there is hardly anything and if there are events they are not advertised at all."

Diversity of population, student interaction (5 responses, 1%)

- "I think diversity is always open for improvement"
- "EMU claiming diversity but not showing diversity"

Safety/law (2 responses, 0%)

- "Title IX and dealing with sexual assault"
- "Improve safety. Inform student of emergencies sooner."

#### **School Characteristics:**

Parking (126 responses, 22%)

- "The parking situation for art students is fairly difficult. There aren't many spots close to the art buildings and the lots that are close you're in competition for the spots with the science complex students."
- "The parking situation could be a lot better. Sometimes it is so hard to find a spot, especially with the parking garage being under construction."
- "The parking is bad. The cost for commuter students is a very steep price, especially when added to the cost of tuition."
- "The parking at EMU should be free for all students."

• "The parking. Students should be charge for parking and then be forced to get to campus an hour early just to park and walk a mile to where their class may be located."

#### Campus, facilities, proximity (48 responses, 8%)

- "The quality of life factor for students living on campus. Specifically, buildings and dining accommodations, and parking. All residence halls on this campus need serious attention. I lived in three different buildings and all three of them didn't feel worth the money. In my 4 years living on campus, I ate the same 3-5 meals over and over because the variety of food available for vegetarians/vegans is so limited. Parking passes are wildly expensive, and have only gone up in price since my first year. The Green Lot is so far from halls like Best and Downing, and this year have the WORST potholes I've ever seen in a major parking lot. To improve these factors would have significantly impacted my experience living on campus, and therefore my experience as a whole."
- "More renovations of older buildings."

#### Affordability, EMU budgeting (37 responses, 6%)

- "Not paying for online classes (the fee for online classes) when no in-person options are available."
- "More scholarships. Classes are very expensive and we do not even have access to course material on canvas after the semester ends. I would have liked to still have my past classes available on canvas. I also do not think there should be a minimum number of credits a student should take to be able to get their scholarship. My last semester I lost my scholarship because I was not enrolled as a "full-time" student and the tuition was very expensive."

#### Food (19 responses, 3%)

- "Food services. The quality of living on campus would be exponentially improved if the food on campus was improved."
- "Food on campus"
