## DILLMAN SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

(awarded in AY 2024-2025)

A number of Dillman Scholarships, up to an amount of \$2000, will be awarded each year to upper-class undergraduate students (juniors and above during the award period; current sophomores may apply), from the bequest left to Eastern Michigan University by Mrs. Jessie Dillman. Applicants must be admitted as full-time music majors to an undergraduate degree program in the School of Music and Dance both Fall and Winter semesters in which they will hold the award, enrolled in a minimum of 12 academic hours both semesters, and have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher at the time of application.

The scholarship will be awarded on the basis of a high level of ability in performance or creativity based upon submitted materials. Creativity is to be interpreted broadly, e.g., composition, research, teaching potential, etc. Applicants should also demonstrate strong leadership within the School of Music & Dance and an active record of performance or creativity outside of EMU.

### Application

To be considered for this award a student must:

- 1. Submit the Dillman application and compulsory essay by email to Prof. John Dorsey (<u>idorsey@emich.edu</u>). The deadline is **March 8, 2024 by 5:00 PM (EST).**
- 2. Have at least <u>two</u> music faculty members complete a Dillman Faculty Recommendation form for you. We kindly request that recommendation letters be typed—not handwritten. Faculty members should complete these forms and submit them by email to John Dorsey (<u>idorsey@emich.edu</u>) by the same deadline.

All application items must be submitted by the deadline. Any applications with missing items (i.e. essays, recommendations letters, etc.) will not be considered.
