

# SHING CHENG SEETOO ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIP IN ORCHESTRAL STRINGS (awarded for 2021 - 2022)

The School of Music and Dance will present the *Shing Cheng Seetoo Endowed Scholarship Award* (\$500) to an outstanding string player (violin, viola, or double-bass) who will be a full-time student during both the Fall and Winter semesters in which they will hold the award. Applicants **must be admitted** to an undergraduate or graduate degree program in the School of Music and Dance and be enrolled in Applied Music. Previous winners are ineligible to apply. This award may be received in addition to other major university or department scholarships.

Due to the wishes of the donor, who also contributed a separate cello scholarship, cellists will not be eligible for this Shing Cheng Seetoo Endowed Scholarship until academic year 2022-2023.

**\*By submitting this application, if you are chosen as the recipient of the scholarship in academic year 2021-2022, you agree to perform a solo selection or selections in the Seetoo Scholarship Celebratory Concert & Fundraiser on November 10, 2022 in Pease Auditorium. One of those selections shall be a piece by a composer of Taiwanese heritage. Please note: this is one academic year after receiving the scholarship.**

## ***Audition: Fully remote/virtual***

Performance videos should include approximately fifteen (15) minutes of music. **Please note** that each video submission may consist of only one performer designated as the entrant, and the piece(s) may be performed only once.

## ***Procedure***

Application and link to your video performance must be submitted by email to Prof. Deborah Pae ([dpae@emich.edu](mailto:dpae@emich.edu)). The deadline is **Tuesday, April 20, 2021 by 5:00 PM (Eastern Standard Time)**.

Please adhere to the following guidelines:

1. Please upload your S.C. Seetoo audition video to YouTube (you must have a YouTube account in order to do this) and set the video as 'Unlisted', then send the link to Prof. Deborah Pae ([dpae@emich.edu](mailto:dpae@emich.edu)). Performances may not be edited or manipulated in any way (i.e. adding reverb or splices within a piece). However, individual pieces or movements may be recorded separately and combined into one unlisted YouTube video.
2. Due to the pandemic, you may submit a video with or without piano accompaniment, or solo piece(s) of your choice. No penalty will be assessed if you perform a selection by yourself that

normally requires accompaniment.

3. Submissions will be adjudicated during the week of Winter Juries (April 21-27) and the S.C. Seetoo Endowed Scholarship Recipient will be notified by the Elections & Awards Committee by the end of final exam week.

Application must contain **complete** program information, including full name of composers, composers' dates, full title of compositions including key and/or opus number as appropriate, name of movements, name of pianist or collaborator if applicable, and accurate timings.
