You can apply for all awards for which you are eligible.

Criteria

John Barson Fellowship

Student must be admitted to the MPA Program and must have demonstrated high scholarship and leadership skills. Recipient must demonstrate a commitment to the field of public administration through undergraduate study, volunteer work, or life experience. Special consideration will be given to applicants specializing in management of public healthcare services. However, all graduate students are eligible for consideration. Applicants: include a letter of interest and a letter of recommendation from an EMU faculty member who is knowledgeable about your work or efforts.

James H. Brickley Scholarship

A scholarship to be awarded to a student in the Political Science Department who has demonstrated a potential for academic excellence, with preference to be given to students who are majoring in, or have taken classes in, Public and Nonprofit Administration. Applicants: include a letter of intent explaining how the award will be used towards a public administration activity or education enrichment.

David Hortin Scholarship in Public Law

Undergraduate student with a minimum GPA of 3.00 and interest in Public Law or Mock Trial. Applicants: submit an essay of NO MORE than two typed pages describing how this scholarship will help further their public law interests and public law co-curricular activities.

Richard Fierens Memorial Scholarship
in Public Law

Awarded to a junior, pre-law student involved in Mock Trial and whose major is in the Political Science Department. Applicants: must demonstrate dedication to leadership and service to fellow students.

Dr. James Donald Johnson Scholarship

Undergraduate student in any major in the Department of Political Science. Overall GPA of at least 2.5. Preference is given to student with financial need as determined by the EMU Office of Financial Aid.

Robert O. McWilliams Memorial Scholarship

Undergraduate students in any major in the Department of Political Science with an overall GPA of at least 3.5. Preference given to a student with financial need as determined by the EMU Office of Financial Aid.
