The Doctoral Training Committee reviews each potential transfer course for equivalency and approval for admitted applicants. Students are responsible for a one-time new student fee of \$200 upon admission. In addition, they are responsible for a \$54 registration fee each semester. These are the only mandatory fees. They are also responsible for all late fees if they fail to register before classes start (\$200), and add (\$200) or change (\$20) classes after the deadline. If students are late in making their payments, they are responsible for a \$70 late fee. EMU is also charging a fee for online courses, though this fee varies depending on number of credits and level of course, which students will also be responsible for. Students may opt to buy a parking pass, the cost of which varies depending on location.
