RECOMMENDATION

2014-15 GENERAL FUND SCHOLARSHIPS, AWARDS AND GRANTS REQUEST

ACTION REQUESTED

It is recommended that the Board of Regents approve the 2014-2015 General Fund Scholarships, Awards and Grants proposal for \$43,822,000.

STAFF SUMMARY

The General Fund Scholarships, Awards and Grants Request is presented to the Board for approval earlier than the normal budget request timeframe to reflect programmatic and funding changes for the next recruitment cycle, and to meet admission publication timelines.

Total FTIAC enrollment for Fall 2013 increased by 285 to 2,880. Growth was realized with the retention of the 2012 FTIAC cohort of 2,595. Many of these students qualified for scholarships and need-based aid for the first time, and many higher academic achieving continuing students maintained their awards. We have moved from 2,100 FTIAC to 2,880 FTIAC over two years, while raising ACT composite by nearly one full point to 22.0.

This request, which represents an 11.8% increase in student aid over the prior year, underscores the dramatic growth in new student enrollment and retention, along with our continued significant financial investment in student education. It also reflects an effort to increase our enrollment through the attraction of more academically prepared students able to succeed with the rigor of an EMU education.

Enrollment goals for 2014-15 include attracting more transfer students, reinforcing recruitment efforts in targeted suburban communities, reflecting a higher yield of financially needy students and anticipating an increased number of retained students qualifying for scholarships.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

The 2014-15 Scholarships, Awards and Grants proposal of \$43,822,000 represents an increase of \$4,620,000 (11.8%) over the 2013-2014 approved budget of \$39,202,000.

The total proposal of \$43,822,000 includes:

Key highlights: 2014-15

The primary source of funding increase reflects the recruitment of a 2013 FTIAC class of 2,850 students, 255 higher than the previous year. The expectation is to continue to recruit a 2014 FTIAC class of 2,850 as reflected in this request.
