#### Narrative in Support of Professor Jamil Baghdachi's Appointment to Emeritus Status

Jamil Baghdachi served 19 years as a Professor in the Polymers and Coatings Program in the College of Technology. He has been awarded numerous honors internally at EMU and nationally. His awards include:

Mattiello Distinguished Lecture Award, American Coatings Association, 2017 Ronald Collins Distinguished Faculty Award in Research. March 2016 American Chemical Society 2015 Roy W. Tess Award in Coatings American Chemical Society 2014 ACS Fellow Industry Excellence Award, American Coating Association, May 2012 Teaching Excellence Award, Eastern Michigan University, 2011 Roon Foundation Best Paper Award, 1" place 2009

These awards include being recognized for outstanding teaching and for outstanding research. Professor Baghdachi was the first EMU professor to be named a Fellow of the American Chemical Society. His scholarship includes editing many books and publishing many research papers. He also has obtained several US patents for EMU during his time at EMU. His research activity has also resulted in his being a PI or co-PI on over \$10M in external grants and contracts, and these funds have been very useful in developing graduate education in polymers and coatings, in addition to depositing almost \$1M in the General Fund of EMU.

His scholarship and teaching contributions make Professor Baghdachi an outstanding candidate for Emeritus Professor status at EMU.
