

## **RESOLUTION**

### **Recognition of Ted Ligibel as the Recipient of the Michigan Historic Preservation Network's 2018 Lifetime Achievement Award**

WHEREAS, the Michigan Historic Preservation Network has selected Ted Ligibel as a recipient of the 2018 Lifetime Achievement Award for his efforts and contributions to preserving Michigan's heritage; and,

WHEREAS, he has been appointed by Governor Rick Snyder as the chair of the State Historic Preservation Review Board, where he will lead professionals from the fields of architecture, history, cultural geography, archaeology, and historic preservation, as they work to honor and preserve our state's history; and,

WHEREAS, Ligibel has served Eastern Michigan University for 27 years as a distinguished professor, and 19 years as director of the nation's largest historic preservation program, inspiring students to advance the historic preservation profession in Michigan and around the world; and,

WHEREAS, Ligibel is chair emeritus of the National Council for Preservation Education, advisor emeritus to the National Trust for Historic Preservation, and has authored numerous historical and architectural works during his illustrious career.
