RECOMMENDATION ACADEMIC YEAR 2022-23 TUITION AND FEES

ACTION REQUESTED

It is recommended that the Board of Regents approve a 3.9% increase in undergraduate tuition and a 2% increase in graduate and doctoral tuition.

Also, recommended are changes to program fees, signature programs, and differential tuition. Those changes are shown on the attached Tuition and Fee document.

The total composite average annual resident undergraduate tuition and fee increase as calculated by the State of Michigan is below the Governor's recommendation of 5.0%. If there are changes to the assumptions used to develop the general fund budget when the State of Michigan budget is approved by the Legislature, this recommendation allows the President to adjust tuition and fees in order to continue to maintain a balanced budget. In any event, this increase will not exceed any tuition restraint cap that the State of Michigan may impose.

Since 2010, Eastern Michigan University's has averaged a 3.99% annual tuition and fee increase.

The recommended tuition and fee increases are incorporated in the recommended 2022-23 General Fund Revenue Budget of \$306.7 million.
