Great Lakes Academy

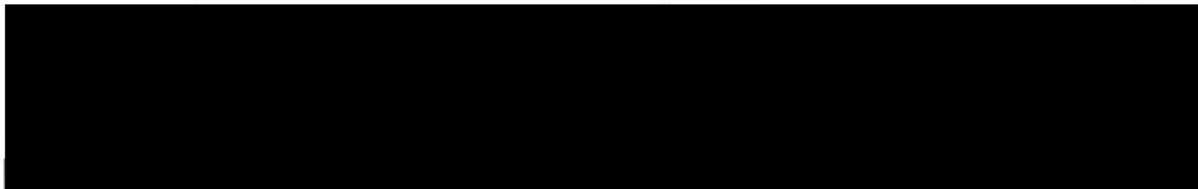

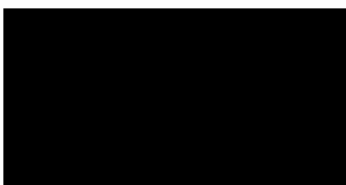
