

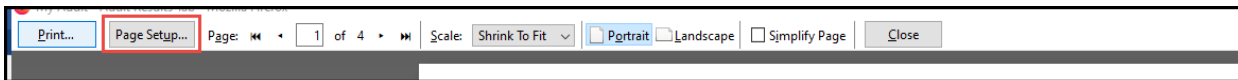
Turning On Graphics For Printing uAchieve Audits

In Firefox:

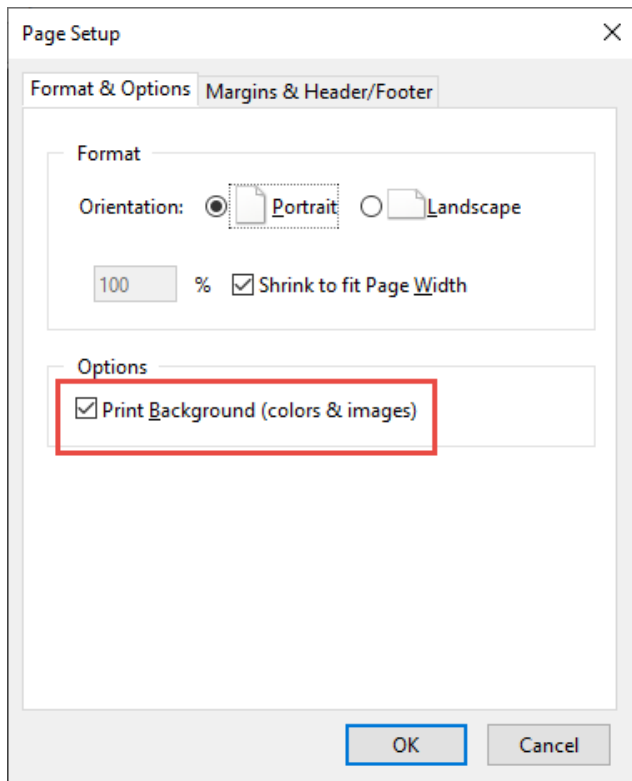
- Click on the 'Printer Friendly' button on the audit

- Go to 'Page Setup'

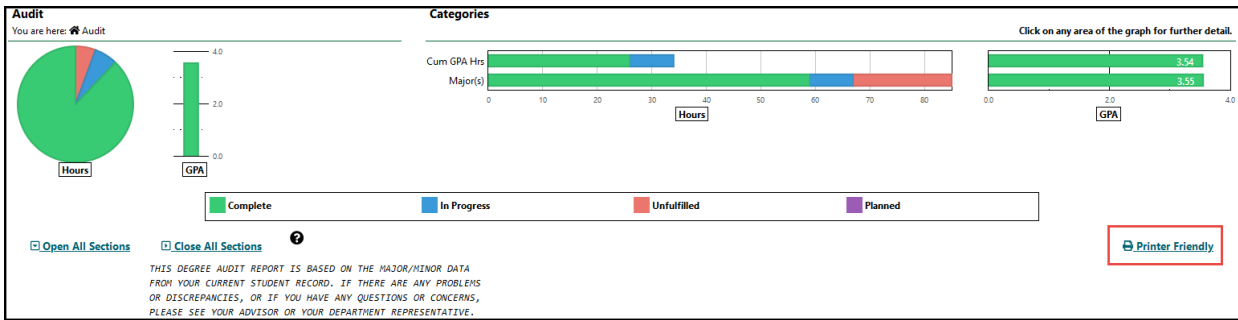


- Make sure the box is checked for 'Print Background (colors & images)'



In Chrome:
