Academic Calendar: There are three full 15 week semesters (Fall, Winter and Summer). Please visit www.emich.edu/registrar for specific registration deadline dates for each term and part of term.

Course Catalog: Students must graduate under catalog requirements that are no older than seven (7) years at the time of graduation. You should review your program requirements with an academic advisor. Please visit catalog.emich.edu to view the most recent catalog. Please note that General Education requirements changed in 2007. Please meet with an advisor if you have questions concerning past or current General Education requirements.

eBill: Bills are no longer mailed to you. You must access your billing information online at ebill.emich.edu.

Probation/Dismissal: At the end of any term of enrollment, to be in good standing, **you must have at least a 2.0 cumulative GPA**. Academic standing is now calculated after each semester – Fall, Winter and Summer. If you have questions about your academic standing, please contact UACDC at the number above. Please note that your financial aid Satisfactory Academic Progress may be different. Contact Financial Aid at (734) 487-0455 if you have questions.
