Undergraduate Student Pass/Fail Request Form Fall 2020 Semester Due January 15, 2021

To accommodate the broad array of adjustments required to carry on the academic mission and operations of Eastern Michigan University during the fall 2020 semester in light of the COVID-19 pandemic, the following temporary change to academic policy has been enacted. Students may elect pass/fail reporting on their academic transcript. The following applies to the **Fall 2020** semester:

- Hours converted to pass/fail will be allowed to satisfy general education requirements
- Hours converted to pass/fail will be allowed to satisfy major/minor requirements
- Hours converted to pass/fail will not be counted toward the 6 course maximum
- All students may choose the pass/fail option, not solely juniors and seniors
- Students should consult with their academic advisor or program advisor regarding how pass/fail grades may be included on a program of study. Not all programs may allow the counting of credit towards specific program requirements.
- Students may choose the pass/fail option up until the last day for withdrawal from the course

Students are encouraged to check with their academic advisor, the Financial Aid Office, Student Athletic Support Services, the Military and Veterans Resource Center and other outside relevant agencies, employers and institutions before making any changes to their course schedules or the recording of their course evaluation.
