

What is the first thing I should do after re-enrolling?

Set up and activate your my.emich account. Please visit my.emich.edu and click on “How do I activate my account (Obtain NetID/Password)?” then select “Activate Account”. You must have your NetID and EID in order to complete the process. Please contact the Office of Records and Registration at (734) 487-4111 to obtain this information if you do not have it. **Please note that all EMU business will be conducted and communicated via your my.emich account.**

Policies have changed and they may impact you...

Academic Calendar: There are three full 15 week semesters (Fall, Winter and Summer). Please visit www.emich.edu/registrar for specific registration deadline dates for each term and part of term.

Course Catalog: Students must graduate under catalog requirements that are no older than seven (7) years at the time of graduation. You should review your program requirements with an academic advisor. Please visit catalog.emich.edu to view the most recent catalog. Please note that General Education requirements changed in 2007. Please meet with an advisor if you have questions concerning past or current General Education requirements.

eBill: Bills are no longer mailed to you. You must access your billing information online at ebill.emich.edu.

Probation/Dismissal: At the end of any term of enrollment, to be in good standing, **you must have at least a 2.0 cumulative GPA and Cumulative Completion Rate (CCR) of 67% or better.** Academic standing is now calculated after each semester – Fall, Winter and Summer. Students on probation will be given one semester to return to good standing or face dismissal. If you have questions about your academic standing, please contact UACDC at the number above. Please note that your financial aid Satisfactory Academic Progress CCR may be different. Contact Financial Aid at (734) 487-0455 if you have questions.
