NEW FOR 2018 - Parking Pass Required for Early Move-In:

You must register your car PRIOR to arriving on campus for early move-in. THEY WILL BE TICKETING IN ALL AREAS OF CAMPUS. You may park in the designated unloading zones to unload, provided you're actively unloading and have your hazard lights on. As soon as you are done, you must move your vehicle to an approved parking area.

Front Desk Hours:

All front desks will be open to residents Sunday, 8/26, through Thursday, 8/30 from 10am to 2pm. Starting Friday, 8/31, all front desks will begin normal business hours—see desks for details.

Mail Services:

Mail and packages will start being delivered to the Residence Halls on Tuesday, 8/28. For all packages, you will receive an email to your @emich.edu account detailing when and where you can pick-up your package. You are required to show picture ID to pick up your packages.

Dining/M meal Plans:

You can begin using your meal plan on Monday, 9/3. Dining venues will have limited hours of operation during early move-in week and over move-in weekend. Please refer to: www.dineoncampus.com/emu to see what venues are open and the hours.

Room/Apartment Key and Card Issues:

Make sure your Eagle ID Card is activated! This is the #1 reason students have issues—your card must be activated to work. If you have any issues with your keys or cards, please go to your front desk for assistance. Night Watch:

Night Watch, our nightly guest sign-in program, begins Wednesday, 8/29. All guests in the building (students and non-students) must be checked in with Night Watch starting at 10pm. Please read the guest policy in the Guide to Campus Living for details.

Construction around Campus:

We are making improvements around campus! These projects may impact the normal flow of traffic and access around campus during the move in process.

Munson Hall: In front of Munson Hall, there is one lane of traffic. Due to safety regulations, residents cannot park their car in front of the hall. Residents will need to unload their vehicles in the Mark Jefferson parking lot. Residents can check-out moving carts from the Apartments Office.

Cornell Courts: The new lighting project is wrapping up, but the sidewalks, courtyards, and parking lots still have some work being done. This work is scheduled to be completed before the start of the fall semester.

Walton, Putnam, Phelps, and Sellers: The Eastern Eateries renovation should be completed by move-in weekend, but there are small projects to finish up during early move-in. You may see contractors working, but this should not impact move-in. Upgrades to lighting fixtures in the hallways should also be done prior to the start of the Fall Semester.

The Village: Has begun having new Heating, Ventilation, Air-Conditioning, (HVAC) units installed. This work should be completed prior to the start of the fall semester.

North Lot Parking: The University is resurfacing the North Lot for parking. This work is also planned to be completed prior to the start of the school year.
