



The Greg O'Dell Student Scholarship

2022-2023

Named in honor of former Eastern Michigan University Police Chief Greg O'Dell, this scholarship is awarded each year to a major in Criminology & Criminal Justice at EMU in recognition of their outstanding community service. It is among the most prestigious awards offered by the Department of Sociology, Anthropology, and Criminology with an approximate value of \$3000 towards student tuition.

Applicants must meet the following criteria to be eligible for the award:

- ❖ A full time registered student (minimum 12 hours), majoring in Criminology and Criminal Justice (CRM)
- ❖ GPA of 3.0 or above
- ❖ In Junior standing (56-84 credit hours) when applying for the scholarship, with at least half of her/his credits from EMU. Maximum transfer credits allowed will be 40.
- ❖ Demonstrated commitment to community service, informed by education in Criminology and Criminal Justice

An application—consisting of a transcript, a personal statement, and an application form—must be submitted to the Department of Sociology, Anthropology and Criminology by **Monday, March 7, 2022, at noon**. The Scholarship will be granted in April, 2022, for the 2022-2023 academic year.

The recipient of the award must submit an exit statement explaining how the award affected her/his senior year at EMU. The recipient also agrees that EMU may use his or her name in publications or press releases related to the grant related event or the scholarship.
