Complete this form to be **considered** for the federal Teacher Education Assistance for College and Higher Education (TEACH) Grant program. The TEACH Grant provides up to \$3,496 per year (\$16,000 total for 4-year undergraduate programs and \$8,000 total for graduate programs) in grants to students who commit to:

- 1. Teach full-time;
- 2. In high-need subject areas;

- 3. For at least four out of the first eight years teaching; and,
- 4. At schools that serve students from low-income families.

If the above commitments are not fulfilled, the TEACH Grant is permanently converted into a loan to be repaid by the student recipient. The loan is a Federal Unsubsidized Loan with interest calculated from the time of the grant disbursement.
